A WIN VS. TROY MEANS...

- Texas State wins its third, and second straight, in the series but trails 13-3 overall.
- The Bobcats move to 31-67 in Sun Belt Conference action since joining the league in 2013.
- Texas State is 8-5 in Sun Belt Conference home openers.
- TXST moves to 50-38-1 all-time in Homecoming games.
- GJ Kinne wins his 20th game at the helm for TXST making him the 6th Bobcat coach to reach 20 wins at the FBS/FCS level.

OPENING DRIVE

- The Bobcats were picked to finish second in the Sun Belt Conference's West Division as announced in the 2025 preseason coaches poll, sharing first-place votes with division-favorite Louisiana.
- TXST won its second consecutive bowl game and finished the 2024 slate 8-5 overall and 5-3 in conference play, winning the most Sun Belt league games for the program since 2014.
- The eight overall wins gave the Bobcats back-to-back seasons of reaching the mark, having not done so since the 1982-83 seasons.
- GJ Kinne became the first head coach to record consecutive eight-win seasons since Jim Wacker in 1981-82.
- TXST enters its final season in the Sun Belt, announcing on June 30 that it will transition to the Pac-12 conference on July 1, 2026.
- Texas State posted the highest home season attendance average the program has seen in 2024 (22,649) besting the 2023 total, and had two sellouts at UFCU Stadium in 2024 (UTSA & Arkansas State).
- In January, Head Coach GJ Kinne announced a trio of football staff updates including the promotion of Landon Keopple to Offensive Coordinator and the hirings of Tanner Burns and Randy Martinez.
- Brad Jackson, Lincoln Pare, Dorion Strawn, Kalil Alexander, Ryan Nolan, Treylin Payne and David Nunez were voted on by their teammates as captains for the 2025 season.
- For the second consecutive season, and third in the last four, Texas State won the Sun Belt Conference's Vic Bubas Cup, which is presented annually to the league's top athletics department.
- Beginning with the 2025 season, the Sun Belt Conference will publish availability reports for all conference football games.
- TXST opens the Johnny and Nathali Weisman Football Performance Center this season, which includes coach's offices, athletic training facilities, the Trevillion Weight Room and team meeting rooms

LAST TIME VS.

TROY, Alabama (AP) — Jordan McCloud accounted for four touchdowns, three of them through the air, and Texas State defeated Troy, 38-17.

McCloud threw three touchdown passes in the first half and Texas State rolled up 298 yards on offense before intermission. Troy also moved the ball well, with 235 yards, but managed only a touchdown and a field goal to trail 28-10.

After a field goal of 53 yards by Mason Shipley put the Bobcats up by three touchdowns, McCloud scored on a 42-yard run on their next possession for a 38-10 lead.

Troy answered with a 19-yard TD pass from Tucker Kilcrease to Devonte Ross, but the Trojans barely crossed midfield on their remaining two full possessions.

After holding on downs at their own 49 with 5:57 remaining, the Bobcats drove to the Troy 23 before McCloud was intercepted in the end zone with 29 seconds left.

McCloud completed 20 of 29 passes for 252 yards with the three touchdowns. Torrance Burgess Jr. had 85 yards rushing and Texas State gained 215 yards on the ground.

The Bobcats finished with a 467-331 advantage in total yards.

LAST TIME OUT

JONESBORO, ARK. (AP) — Jaylen Raynor completed five straight passes in the final minute before scoring on a 4-yard run and Arkansas State rallied last in a 31-30 victory over Texas State.

Raynor's five passes went to four different receivers and covered the first 71 yards for the Red Wolves. Clune Van Andel's extra-point kick was the difference after a TXST miss that left the Bobcats leading 30-24 with 61 seconds remaining.

Brad Jackson's 63-yard run on first down set up Lincoln Pare's 3-yard touchdown run one play later to give Texas State the late lead. The Bobcats used Jackson's 24-yard touchdown run for a 7-0 lead on their opening possession. Raynor tied it with a 13-yard touchdown run.

Van Andel and Robles traded second-quarter field goals for a 10-10 tie at halftime.

After a scoreless third quarter, Jackson hit Titus Lyons for a 13-yard touchdown and a 17-10 lead with 12:11 left to play. Raynor answered with a 5-yard scoring toss to Hunter Summers to tie it with 6:43 to go.

Pare's 4-yard touchdown run put the Bobcats up 24-17 at 3:48, but Raynor hit Kenyon Clay for a 5-yard score with 1:20 left to tie it 24-all.

Jackson had 230 yards on 18-for-26 passing and added 131 yards on 10 carries. Pare rushed 21 times for 105 yards.

HOMECOMING SATURDAY

Saturday is Homecoming football at Texas State. The Bobcats will don their throwback Southwest Texas jerseys. TXST is 49-31-1 all-time in Homecoming match-ups.

VICTORY STAR

Texas State is coming off back-to-back bowl victories with wins in the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl following the 2023 and 2024 seasons.

- The Bobcats set an FBS program record for wins in a season with 8 in 2023 and matched that total during the 2024 season.
- The last time Texas State had 8 wins in a season was in 2008 when the Bobcats were 8-4 in the regular season and finished the year with a first-round loss at Montana in the Division I-AA (FCS) Playoffs first round.
- TXST won its second consecutive bowl game and finished the 2024 slate 8-5 overall and 5-3 in conference play, winning the most Sun Belt league games for the program since 2014.
- The eight overall wins gave the Bobcats back-to-back seasons of reaching the mark, having not done so since the 1982-83 seasons.
- GJ Kinne became the first head coach to record consecutive eight-win seasons since Jim Wacker in 1981-82.
- Texas State has 15 seasons in its program history with 8 or more wins.

SAME BOBCATS, NEW CONFERENCE

Texas State University has officially accepted an invitation to join the Pac-12 Conference, a transformative milestone in the university's athletic and academic journey. After receiving a formal invitation for application and subsequent submission, the Pac-12 Board of Directors, including all eight current and future members of the new Pac-12, voted unanimously to admit TXST to the conference effective July 1, 2026.

THE KINNE EFFECT

In his first year, Texas State head coach GJ Kinne took the Bobcats to a place they have never gone -- a bowl game -- and did something that has not been done in 40 years.

- Kinne is the first Texas State head coach to have a winning season in his first campaign at the helm of the Bobcats since Dennis Franchione in 1990 (6-5).
- With the bowl win, Kinne became the first, first-year head coach at Texas State to win 8 or more games since John O'Hara in 1983 (9-3).



TEXAS STATE vs. TROY

O'Hara took over the Bobcats after they won back-to-back DII national championships under Jim Wacker in 1981 and 1982.

- Prior to Kinne, only 2 Texas State head coaches in the program's history had won 8 or more games in their first season: O'Hara (1983) and Bill Miller (8-2 in 1965).
- Kinne was named the 21st head coach in Texas State's history on Dec. 2, 2022 (one day after his 34th birthday).

HOTTEST TICKET IN TOWN

The Bobcats sold out 2 of 7 home games in 2024 with crowds of 28,000 against UTSA and Arkansas State (1st SBC home sellout). TXST sold out the Sept. 20 game vs Nicholls and is averaging 26,291 at home in 2025.

EXCITING BRAND OF FOOTBALL

One thing that GJ Kinne and the rest of the Texas State coaching staff installed over its first two seasons is an offense that has produced at its highest level in the Bobcats' FBS history.

- Texas State was a top 10 total (5, 476.9) and scoring (7, 36.5) offense in 2024.
- TXST finished 2024 22nd in the country in passing offense (268.7) and 15th in rushing offense (208.2).
- Entering 2023 as an FBS team, Texas State had never ranked higher than 24th in the nation in total offense. In 2014, the Bobcats finished the season 24th in total offense, which was the only time they had been in the nation's top-50 in that category.
- Also entering the 2024 season, Texas State's highest finish as an FBS team in rushing offense was 18th (2014) and passing offense was 56th (2020).
- The Texas State offense averaged 151.7 more yards per game in 2024 compared to 2022.

On the other side of the ball, Texas State held opponents under 101 rushing yards 5 times in 2024, going 4-1 in those outings.

GETTING TO THE BACKFIELD

TXST finished the 2024 season ranked in the top 20 nationally for tackles for loss (10th, 7.4) and sacks (18th, 2.77).

- Texas State registered 7 sacks in the 2024 opener against Lamar. The most for TXST in an FBS game behind eight vs Idaho on Oct. 4, 2014 and the most since six against South Alabama Nov. 5, 2023.
- The Bobcats finished with 36 sacks for 281 yards (2nd most in the FBS era - 40 in 2023).
- The overall program record for sacks in a season is 58.5 set in 1982.
- In 2024, TXST had 5 games with 8+ TFLs and 8 games with 3+ sacks.

BORN TO BE BOBCATS

Texas State has two unique Bobcat specialists on the roster in 2025 - David Nunez and Michael James.

- Nunez has been a mainstay on the TXST roster since the 2020 season, having his breakout season in 2024. The Houston native played in all 13 games last season registering 15 punts for 575 yards (avg. 38.3) and pinning 11 inside the 20. He was on the throwing end of a successful two-point conversion attempt to Konner Fox against Lamar and caught a successful attempt against Sam Houston. A former walk-on, Nunez was put on scholarship on Aug. 9, 2025.
- Kicker James starts his second stint as a Bobcat after spending the 2024 season at Tarleton State. James played in 9 games as a kickoff specialist in San Marcos from 2022-23.

GJ KINNE

HEAD COACH
THIRD SEASON

GJ Kinne was named the head coach of Texas State football on December 2, 2022. And in a year's time, the native Texan – and third-youngest coach in FBS – took the Bobcats to newfound heights in 2023 – and on an ascent to more in 2024.

Kinne, who was tabbed as the 21st head coach in program history when he was officially hired a day after his 34th birthday, led the Bobcats to an FBS program record eight wins in his first season at the helm of Texas State and to the program's first appearance and win in a bowl game.

In his second season at Texas State, Kinne led the Bobcats to back-to-back bowl wins. The 2024 season saw seven regular season wins, marking the third time TXST has reached that mark since entering the FBS ranks in 2012, and gave the Bobcats consecutive winning seasons for the first time since 2008-09. Texas State finished the regular season 7-5 with a 5-3 record in Sun Belt Conference action, matching the most conference wins at the FBS level. The Bobcats also won three games in November for the first time since 2014, and it was the first season since 2014 with three road wins.

The former NFL and collegiate quarterback inherited a Texas State program that had not had a winning season in 9 years. After bringing in 53 scholarship newcomers – and 71 total new players – over the spring and summer of 2023, Kinne and his staff guided the Bobcats to a season-opening win at Baylor (the program's first win over a "Power 5" team), a 3-1 non-conference record, a 5-1 record at home, and a tied-for-second-place finish in the Sun Belt West Division standings. The Bobcats capped the season with a dominating 45-21 win over Rice in the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl in Dallas to finish 8-5 in Kinne's inaugural season.

The Bobcats doubled their wins from the previous season with the help of the nation's most improved scoring offense in 2023. Texas State averaged 36.7 points on offense, which was more than a 15-point improvement from the prior season and finished as the 14th-best scoring unit in the country. The Bobcats were also 14th in the nation in total offense (457.6 yards/game), 25th in rushing offense (186.7), and 28th in passing offense (270.9). It was the first time Texas State finished in the top-30 in the country in all 4 categories in an FBS season.

The Bobcats scored 40+ points in 6 games over the course of the season, including 3 times in conference play. They scored 77 points in the home opener against Jackson State, which fell one shy of the program's record for most in a single game, and ended the year with 45+ points in each of their final 2 games.

The high-scoring offense was led by All-American all-purpose player Ismail Mahdi and quarterback TJ Finley. Mahdi, who was named a first team All-American by CBS Sports/247Sports, led the country in all-purpose yards (2,169) and scored 12 total touchdowns in 13 games. Finley, meanwhile, set the program's overall single-season record for most passing yards by throwing for 3,439 yards. He also totaled 29 touchdowns in his first season as a Bobcat.

While the offense garnered the headlines, the other two phases under Kinne and his staff were among the nation's leaders as well. The defense finished first in tackles for loss and eighth in sacks. Special teams, meanwhile, was sixth in the country in kick returns with an average of 26.08 yards. The Bobcats also returned 2 kickoffs for touchdowns, which matched their record for most in season (previous: 2013).

Texas State also garnered seven All-Sun Belt selections as well as four honorable mentions in 2023. Ismail Mahdi was a first team all-purpose selection and second team kick returner while kicker Mason Shipley (first team), wide receiver Joey Hobert (second team) and offensive lineman Brey Walker (third team) earned accolades from the offensive and special teams side. Linebacker Brian Holloway and defensive end Ben Bell were second team selections from the defense. Quarterback TJ Finley, wide receivers Kole Wilson and Ashtyn Hawkins, and defensive back Shawn Holton garnered honorable mention.

In addition to the record for most wins in an FBS season, Texas State set 20 FBS program records for a single season in Kinne's first campaign. The offense set 13 different FBS records while the defense set 5 (sacks, TFLs, hurries and forced fumbles) and special teams turned in 3 (field goals made, kick return average, kick return touchdowns).

The Bobcats also set 29 individual FBS season program records in 2023, including 9 by TJ Finley, 5 by Ismail Mahdi, 4 each by Joey Hobert and Mason Shipley, 2 each by Brian Holloway and Ben Bell, and 1 each by Shawn Holton, Kaleb Culp, and Kole Wilson.

Kinne rebooted Texas State football behind the mantra "Take Back Texas." Kinne, who is a son of a Texas high school coach and was born and raised in the state, and his staff put together a 2023 newcomer class that was rated by 247Sports as the program's best in its FBS history. The Bobcats used the injection of new talent by going 7-2 within the state of Texas during the season and picking up two wins in three games against Texas schools.

In mid-October, Kinne was named to the 2023 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Watch List. He was one of 26 coaches -- and one of five from the "Group of 5" conferences -- to be in consideration for the annual top honor at the halfway point of the season.

An offensive mastermind with NFL experience and deep roots in the state of Texas, Kinne arrived in San Marcos after helping lead Incarnate Word to a Southland Conference championship, No. 7 national ranking, and a national seed in the FCS Playoffs in 2022. The Cardinals reached the semifinals of the FCS Playoffs and went 12-2.

The Cardinals were an up-tempo, high-flying offense in 2022 under Kinne. They ranked No. 1 in all of NCAA Division I – FBS and FCS – with 51.5 points and 581.2 yards per game. The team also had a defense to match as it ranked first in FCS in tackles for loss, ninth in sacks, and 38th in scoring defense.

Kinne was an FCS finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award in 2022, which is presented to the nation's top coach.

While Kinne was in the running for national awards, he coached the 2022 Walter Payton Award winner in Lindsey Scott Jr. The quarterback thrived under Kinne as he totaled 71 touchdowns (60 passing, 11 rushing), threw for 4,686 yards, and rushed for 712. Scott Jr. finished the year first in FCS in passing efficiency, second in passing yards, and third in completion percentage. He was also named the Southland Conference Player of the Year.

Originally from Mesquite, Texas, Kinne was a highly-rated quarterback recruit out of high school who went on to be a three-year starter at Tulsa and then embarked on a five-year professional career in the NFL and CFL. In high school, Kinne played for Jeff Taylor, the current head coach at UTSA, at Gilmer High School (TX).

Kinne's father, Gary Joe, was a standout linebacker at Baylor and later coached at Allen High School, Kaufman High School, Mesquite High School and Canton High School (head coach). Gary Joe also coached at Baylor.

Kinne has coached at both the collegiate and NFL levels, starting as a graduate assistant at SMU in 2017 to an offensive assistant with the Philadelphia Eagles in 2019 to his head coaching roles. He has worked with some of the industry's top play-callers, including Doug Pederson, Gus Malzahn, Mike Norvell, Chad Morris and Chip Kelly.
