WHEN THE LIGHTS GO DOWN IN THE CITY - The Pepperdine men's basketball team will play its last road conference game in San Francisco Saturday evening, where the Waves will take on the Dons in War Memorial Gymnasium.

LAST TIME OUT - Pepperdine held its lead over Pacific throughout the entire 40 minutes Wednesday night and saw career-bests from Michael Ajayi and Malik Moore as the Waves rolled to an 89-70 win in Stockton Wednesday night. Ajayi earned his 14thdouble-double, which moved him up the Pepperdine singleseason leaderboard to fifth, tying Dana Jones (1992-93) and Moore recorded 20 points for a new career high in that category. The win was the Waves' third in five outings.

AJAYI ON THE DOUBLE - Michael Ajayi recorded his 14th double-double on 30 points and 17 rebounds Wednesday night which moved the junior up the Pepperdine single-season double-double leaderboard to tie Dana Jones (1992-93) at fifth place. His next double-double instance would put Ajayi tied for third with Jones (1993-94) and Stacy Davis (2015-16) at 15-total.

PORTER POWER – Sophomore Jevon Porter comes off of a stellar debut season where he started all 31 games for the Waves. Porter shocked the league in double-doubles as well, becoming the only freshman to accrue one and ending the season with eight total. Now since his return from injury, the sophomore has averaged 15.1 points and 5.8 rebounds per game and earned a season-high 26 points against Pacific on January 11 as well as his first double-double of the year against LMU on January 20 with 24 points and 12 boards.

MALLETTE MADNESS - The Waves' leader on and off the court, Houston **Mallette** sits third on the Pepperdine season box score in scoring, pouring in 15 points per game. The junior is also fifth in the WCC in the same category and in three-pointers per game with 2.2. Mallette has totaled 1,276 points in his three years in Malibu.

SPARKPLUG STANSBERRY - Redshirt-freshman **Cord Stansberry** has earned a reputation as the team's energy supplier after entering games and immediately providing a spark. Against USF, Stansberry hit two dagger threes in the first half to keep Pepperdine close with the Dons while the guard took matters into his own hands against LMU, scoring eight points in consecutive offensive plays capitalized by a steal and breakaway dunk. Since then, Stansberry has averaged a .520 clip from field goal range and 42.1% from beyond the arc.

WAVES VS WCC - Michael Ajayi currently ranks in the top five of four different categories in the conference: First in scoring (17.7 PPG), second in rebounding (9.5 RPG) and fourth in field goal percentage (.467) and fourth in minutes (34.3 MPG). Houston Mallette also ranks in the top 10 for the following WCC categories: Fifth in scoring (15.0 PPG) and in threes per game (2.2) as well as fourth in free-throw percentage (.816) and eighth in field goal percentage (.432). As a team, the Waves shoot 36.1% from beyond the arc which is good for first in the conference and pull down an average of 10.2 offensive boards for fourth in the league.

CONFERENCE CALL – Junior Houston Mallette and sophomore Jevon Porter were named to the West Coast Conference Preseason squad, announced in early October. The last time Pepperdine put two names on the preseason team was the 2020-21 season, in which the Waves' all-time leading scorer **Colbey Ross** and **Kessler Edwards** achieved the feat. The honor is also the second-straight such award for Mallette after he became the lone Wave on the preseason team last year.

LIKE MIKE - Six-foot-seven forward **Michael Ajayi** started high school at just five-foot-seven. Though he played basketball since grade school, he was overlooked for the varsity roster at Kentwood High until his senior year, stunting any college looks his way. Ajayi's lone offer came from Pierce College in Puyallup, Wash. where he grew his final two inches and averaged similar numbers to his current Pepperdine line (22 PPG, 13 RPG, 3 APG) and it was none other than Romar alum Isaiah Thomas who touted Ajavi's prowess after playing pick-up with Ajayi to his former college coach- the rest is history.

ROMAR – Head coach **Lorenzo Romar** is in his 27th season as a collegiate head coach. This year will also be his sixth this time around in Malibu and his ninth overall with the Waves. Known around the country for his recruiting prowess, Romar has coached 27 current and former NBA players, including Pepperdine standouts **Kessler Edwards** (Sacramento Kings) and **Maxwell Lewis** (Los Angeles Lakers).

UNC – Carson-native **Ethan Anderson** returns home this season to spend his last collegiate year as a Wave. The veteran point guard played his high school days at Fairfax before heading down the road to USC where he graduated in three years. In a Trojans uniform, Anderson averaged 5.2 points, three assists and 2.3 rebounds per game as one of the Trojans' team captains and helped USC to two NCAA tournament appearances (including an Elite Eight run during the 20-22 season as Southern California routed the likes of Drake, Kansas and Oregon en route to an 85-66 loss to top-ranked Gonzaga). Anderson then transferred to Wyoming, where contributed 7.9 points and 4.3 boards per contest. The Waves lovingly refer to him as "Unc" due to his tenured career.

PRO WAVES – Following **Max Lewis's** exit into the Lakers' hands, Pepperdine currently has two former Waves in the NBA. The aforementioned Lewis was the 40th pick in the 2023 Draft and earned big minutes in the NBA Summer League. **Kessler Edwards** began his professional career with the Brooklyn Nets who drafted him at 44th in 2021 but has since been traded to the Sacramento Kings. Pepperdine's leading-scorer **Colbey Ross** currently plays for Bucucnost VOLI in Montenegro- one of the top teams in its league.

ROSTER NOTES – Returning letter-winners for the Waves this season include Mallette, Porter, **Jalen Pitre**, **Malik Moore**, **Boubacar Coulibaly** and **Aladji Gassama**. They are joined by four true freshmen- **Martin Gumwel**, **John Squire**, **Curtis Williams** and **Nils Cooper**- and two transfers- **Michael Ajayi** and **Ethan Anderson**. The Waves hold the third-most returning minutes in the WCC at 54.7%.

FAMILY TIES — **Nils Cooper's** father is five-time NBA champion and Lakers legend Michael Cooper ... **David Mager's** father, Scott, played basketball at Fairleigh Dickinson and attended Pepperdine's School of Law ... **Houston Mallette's** father, Wesley, was a two-sport athlete at James Madison and is now the athletic director at UC Riverside ... **Jevon Porter** has two older brothers (Michael Jr. and Jontay) who have played at Missouri and in the NBA, while both parents and three other siblings have played college basketball ... **Cord Stansberry's** grandfather is Chet Kammerer, a long-time member of the Miami Heat front office and the former head coach at Westmont College (where the court is named after him).

PEPPERDINE BASKETBALL — This is the 86th season of Pepperdine men's basketball, and the 51st year that the Waves have called Firestone Fieldhouse home. The Waves has been to the NCAA Tournament 13 times (last in 2002) and has won 12 West Coast Conference regular-season titles (last in 2002) and three WCC Tournament crowns (last in 1994). The Waves won the College Basketball Invitational in 2021.



LORENZO ROMAR

Lorenzo Romar, who has been a successful head coach for more than two decades and is known as one of the nation's top recruiters, returned to Pepperdine prior to the 2018-19 season for his second stint in charge of the men's basketball program.

At the start of the 2023-24 season, Romar had a career record of 454-377 over 26 seasons as a head coach at Pepperdine, Saint Louis and Washington.

After an initial rebuilding season in his first season as a head coach at Pepperdine in 1996-97, he led the Waves to 17 and 19 wins the next two years. An 11-win improvement from year one to year two ranked as one of



the nation's top turnarounds. In 2018-19, he took the Waves from six to 16 victories, meaning that he's been responsible for two of the four times in Pepperdine history that the Waves have improved by double-digit wins. He led Pepperdine to its first postseason title since 1994 with the 2021 CBI championship.

At UW, he built the Huskies into a perennial contender over 15 seasons. He helped produce 11 NBA first-round draft picks and 17 NBA players, while his teams played in six NCAA Tournaments, three NITs and one CBI. He was a three-time Pac-10 or Pac-12 Coach of the Year.

At Washington and Arizona, where he was the associate head coach for one season before coming to Pepperdine, Romar worked with back-to-back NBA #1 overall draft picks (Markelle Fultz and DeAndre Ayton). As a head coach, he's produced 17 NBA Draft picks (most recently Kessler Edwards in 2021) and a total of 26 as either a head coach or assistant.

Romar won an NCAA title as an assistant coach at UCLA in 1995. He was selected in the seventh round of the 1980 NBA Draft and played five seasons in the NBA. He played collegiately at Washington.

Associate head coach **Ken Bone**, a former head coach at Washington State, Portland State and Seattle Pacific, was also an assistant coach under Romar at Washington for three seasons.

Assistant coach **Curtis Allen** played for Romar at Washington and was an assistant coach at Washington State for nine seasons (he was an assistant to Bone at both WSU and Portland State).

Assistant coach **Gerald Brown** is a former Pepperdine great who played for Romar for two seasons and was a three-time All-WCC first team honoree between 1994-98. He played a season in the NBA with the Phoenix Suns and was also briefly a Harlem Globetrotter.

Assistant coach **Daniel Eberhardt** who enters his first season in Malibu after 11 years of coaching experience with his most recent stop as an assistant on the women's side at Cal Poly in San Luis Obispo.

Two 2022 graduates, four-year player **Darryl Polk Jr.** and former student manager **Ryan Williams**, are now graduate managers.



ON THE DONS

Sitting third in the WCC, San Francisco most recently saw a sixgame winning streak snapped in a close contest at Saint Mary's. The usually rebound-heavy Dons were outdone by the Gaels on the glass pulling down only 23 to SMC's 36 in a game where USF had the upper hand in shooting accuracy.

Forward Jonathan Mogbo leads the team in scoring (14.9) and rebounds (10.3)— a stat where he also leads the conference. He also holds the reins as the Dons' leader in steals, going for 1.8 per game.

Back in Firestone on February 8, Pepperdine stayed competitive against San Francisco in a bout that saw six lead changes but the Dons ran away with an 80-74 win. The Waves matched USF in rebounds (33 each) and turnovers (nine each) but the Dons controlled the paint to eke out the six-point win. Jevon Porter led Pepperdine with 21 points and nine boards, followed by Houston Mallette with 19 points on 5-of-6 field goal shooting.
