**Morning Worship 10:45am** – Have you ever noticed how family can be one of the most special things in the world and yet also the source of some of the hardest struggles of one's life? Why is that? For two weeks, we will look at Genesis 26. The most important lesson is that God resets the covenant with Isaac. But something unusual happens: Isaac's life looks a whole lot like his dad's. This week we are taught about God's blessing of family. Next week, family sins.

But our worship service every week has been focused on Christ the Redeemer. This week we worship Christ because he is rightly the Object of Worship.
