Dear friends.

Well, we've been here for two weeks! It's been a whirlwind and the Lord has taken such amazing care of us.

Our **flights were totally fine**. Everything went smoothly – except for our ability to count at the Prague airport. We counted 9 checked bags, forgetting that we had gate checked one. We got home to the Hunts and didn't realized that we were missing a bag until Saturday. We had arrived on Monday. So, after a little (ok, a lot of) freaking out and some calling, on Sunday, we were back at the airport to pick up our lost (to us) bag.

Our **language abilities** are about where they were when we left. Masks are not very helpful in reading facial expressions! My first real experience back was at the foreigners' police. Yes, it's a real thing here. But I understood and was understood. An excellent experience overall. Evan has Czech class daily, and I am looking for options for my Czech.

We stayed for a week with our team leader/pastor and his family, and are now at an Airbnb. It's been wonderful. There are two bedrooms and even a piano. As Evan said, "God is spoiling us!".

Evan started **school** on Wednesday and is doing well. He has made some connections that we pray will be friends. It takes about 35-40 minutes to get to and from school, which in Prague is not too far. Right now I'm taking him and picking him up until we both get a little more used to knowing where the bus/tram/metro stops are. Pray that by the end of the week he will be able to do it himself. Right now I'm spending about three hours a day on public transportation!

We have been to our **church** twice. It has been so good to be there. After/in the midst of COVID it's hard to find good continuity, but our church is moving forward with those the Lord has brought together.

Please continue to pray for housing for us. I'm going to be contacting a realtor to help us navigate it all – which is fairly typical here. Ideally, we'd like to move into our long-term home before the end of September.
