**Beginning the first Wednesday in August (7<sup>th</sup>) the weekly prayer meeting** will be preceded by a prepared meal for those who find it helpful to their schedule to be able to eat at the church. - People may arrive at 5:30, and meals will be served from 5:45 – 6:30, with cleanup starting at 6:45 in preparation for prayer meeting at 7.
- Those who plan to participate regularly in the dinner, please sign up once with Ginger, and after that simply notify her if you are unable to make it, or if you plan to bring other people. For those who do not plan to participate regularly, simply notify Ginger the Sunday before if you would like to attend the Wednesday meal that week.
- Cost is \$5 for adults, \$3 for children (12 and under) with a \$20 max per family. Pay when you arrive.
- Of course, meal participation is not mandatory for prayer meeting! Prayer meeting will begin for everyone at 7:00.

**Next Lord's Day (August 4) is the first Sunday of the month**, and we will observe the Lord's Supper together, as well as enjoy our fellowship meal. Please prepare your hearts for the Sacrament and plan to join in the communion of the saints as we fellowship together.

“**Orthodox**” (literally, “straight thinking”) signifies our holding steadfastly to the inerrancy of Scripture, not in a thoughtless faith, but one that recognizes God’s Word as the foundation for consistent “straight thinking.” “**Presbyterian**” signifies that we believe the Scriptures to teach that local church elders along with a pastor, form a “session” to care for the spiritual welfare of the members of the **Church**, while not presuming to interfere with their freedom of conscience in matters of Christian liberty.
