OVERVIEW

Using Greek Amphora as their guide students will learn one of the main handbuilding techniques of stacking and joining coils to build a coil pot 10 – 12” in height. Students will demonstrate their mastery of this technique and this construction process will prepare students for more complex forms in the future. Sgraffito, a system of adding and scraping away underglaze, will be used to create unique patterns on the surface.
