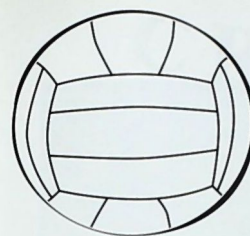
FOOTBALL 01

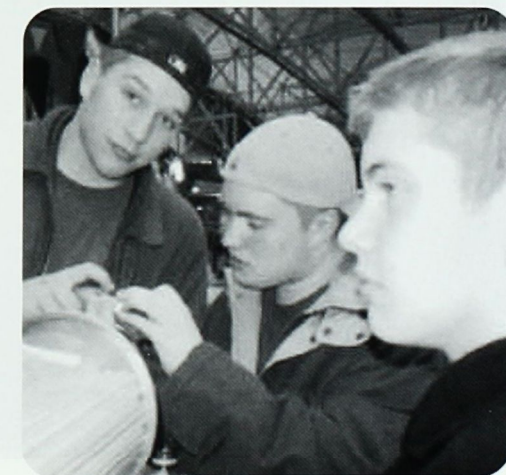
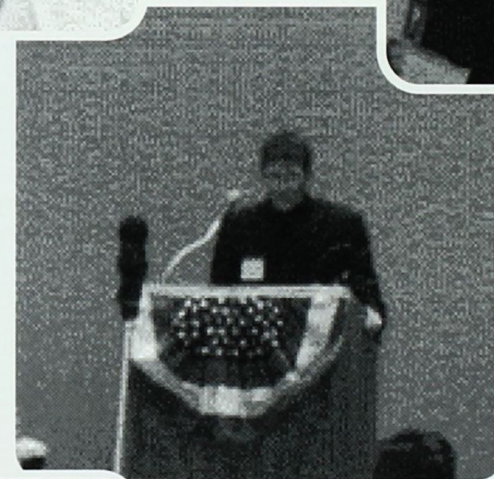
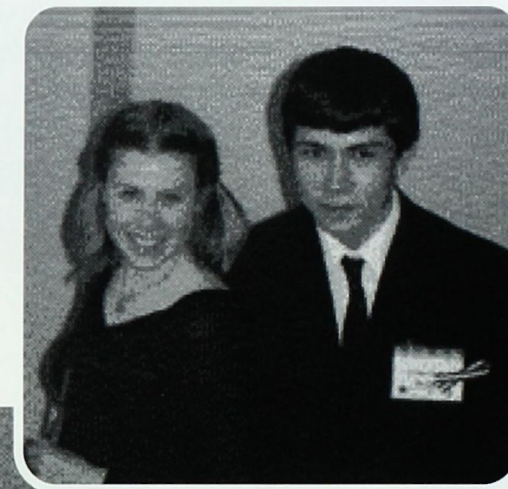
Model United Nations
