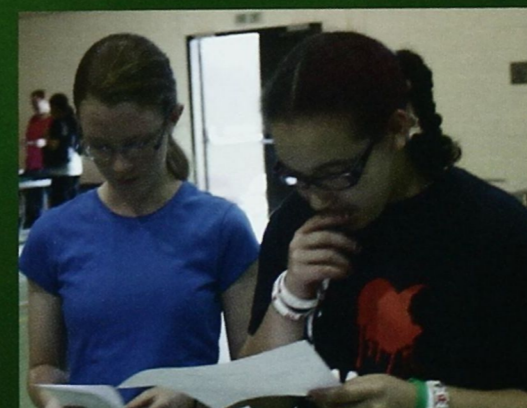
# 9/11 Ceremony

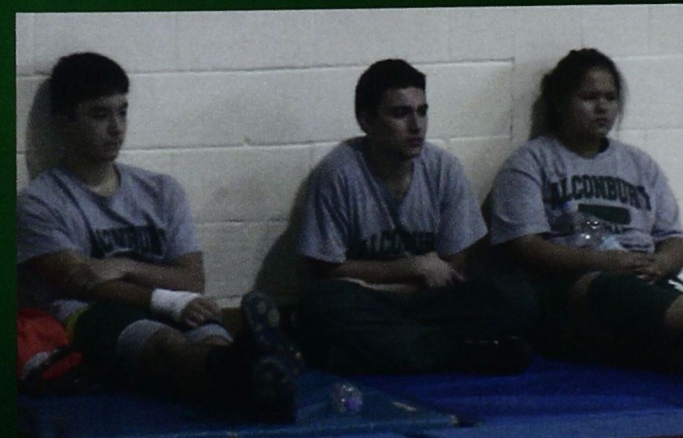

# Academics



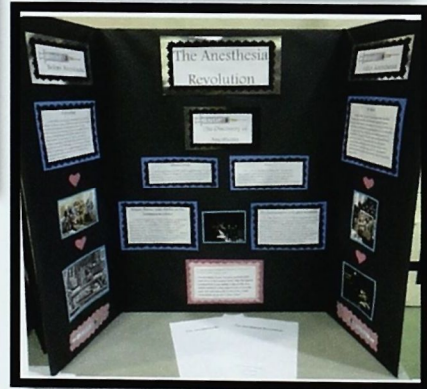
# National History Day

Mr. Ballard teaches his sixth grade students the importance of physical, social, mental, and emotional health.

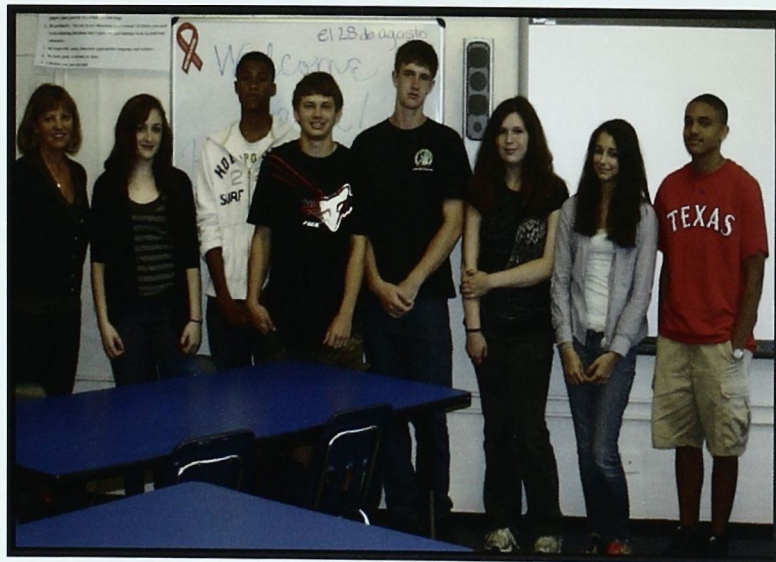

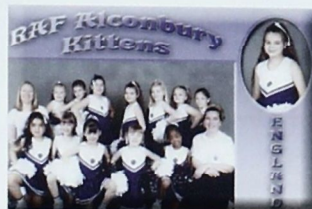


*A letter to Ronnie at her graduation.*
