# Fall Spirit Week

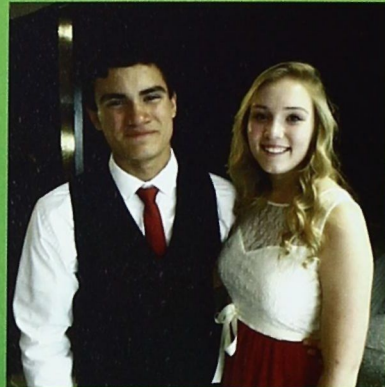

Every year on September 11th we hold a ceremony not only to pay our respects, but also to remember how our lives were irrevocably changed on that day 12 years ago.



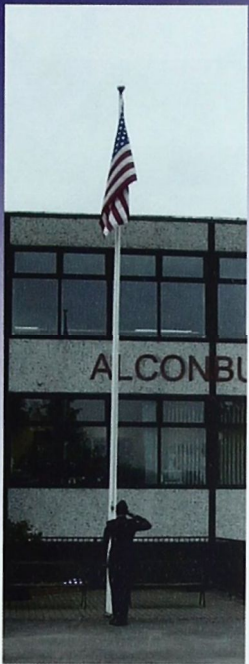

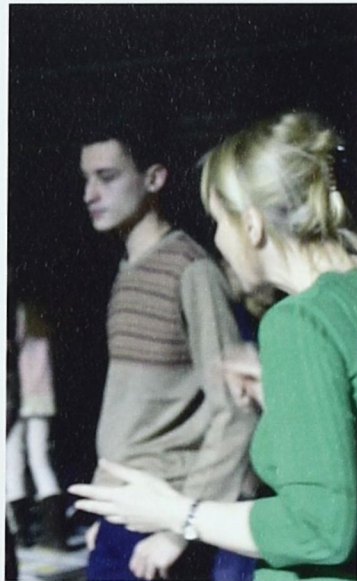
# Drill Europeans

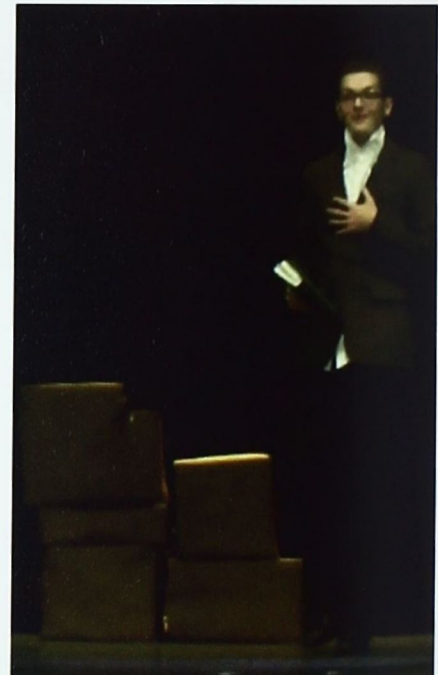
# Drama Club

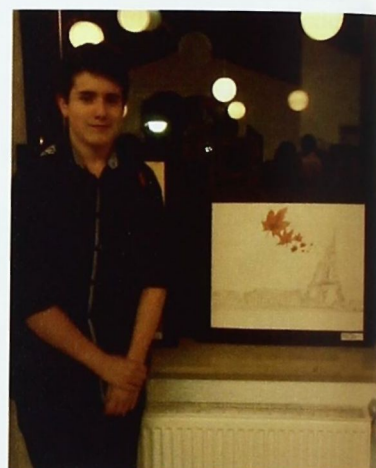

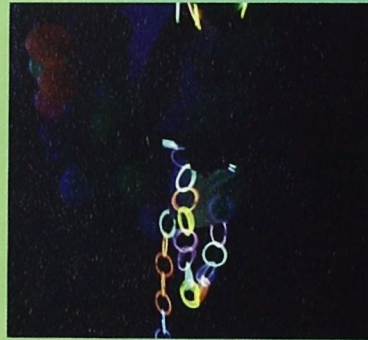




# Neon Night

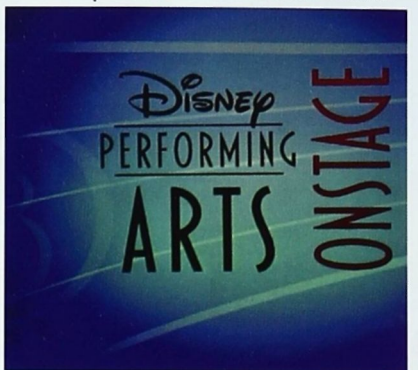

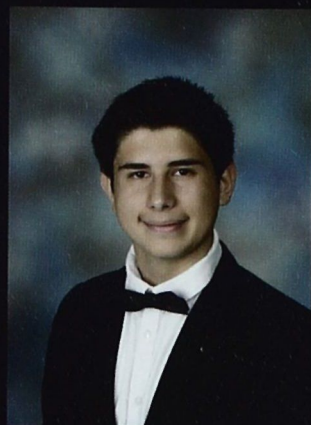
# Disney Trip

# Model of United Nations

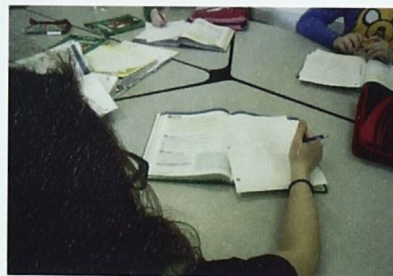
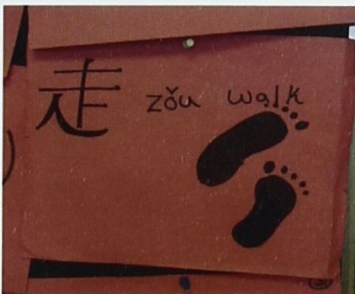
# English

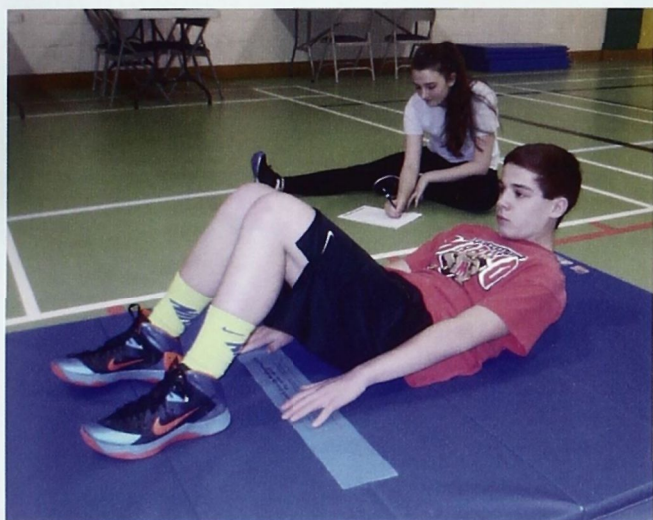


# Foreign Language

Health was instructed by Coach Ballard. This class teaches about having a good diet and the importance of mental, social, emotional, and physical health.

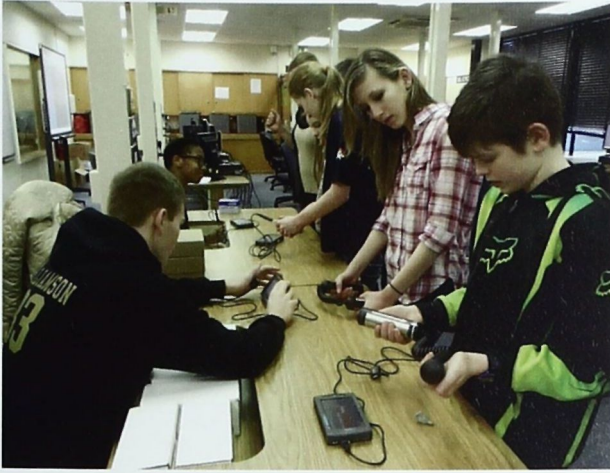

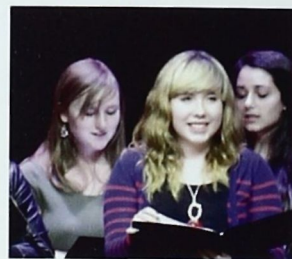
# Band
