Located in the Western Pacific in the geographic region known as Micronesia, Guam is well known for its strategic military and economic position between Asia and the North American continent. There are two major military bases on the island, Andersen Air Force Base on the northern tip and Naval Base, Guam, to the south.

Land Area: 212 square miles; Approx 30 miles long, 4-9 miles wide

Official Languages: English and Chamorro

Population: 175,877 (2008 estimate)

Currency: US Dollar

Political Status: Unincorporated Territory of the United States

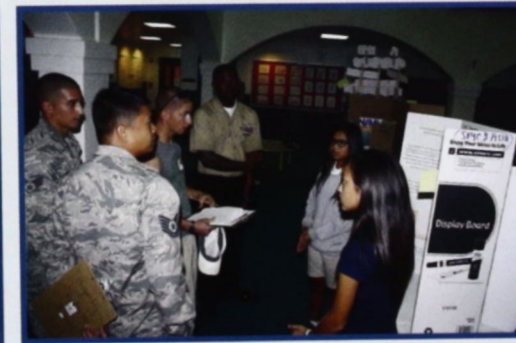
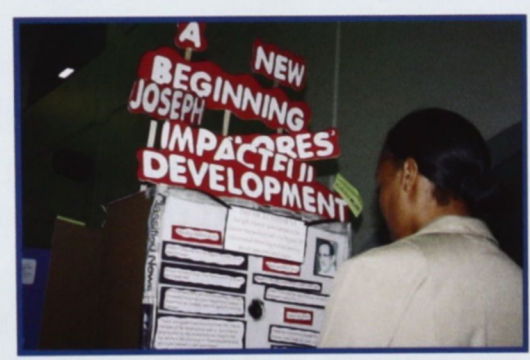
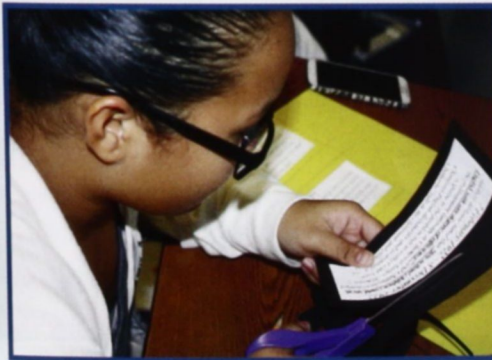
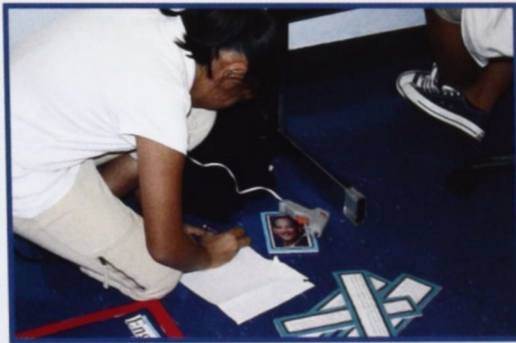
(National History Day)

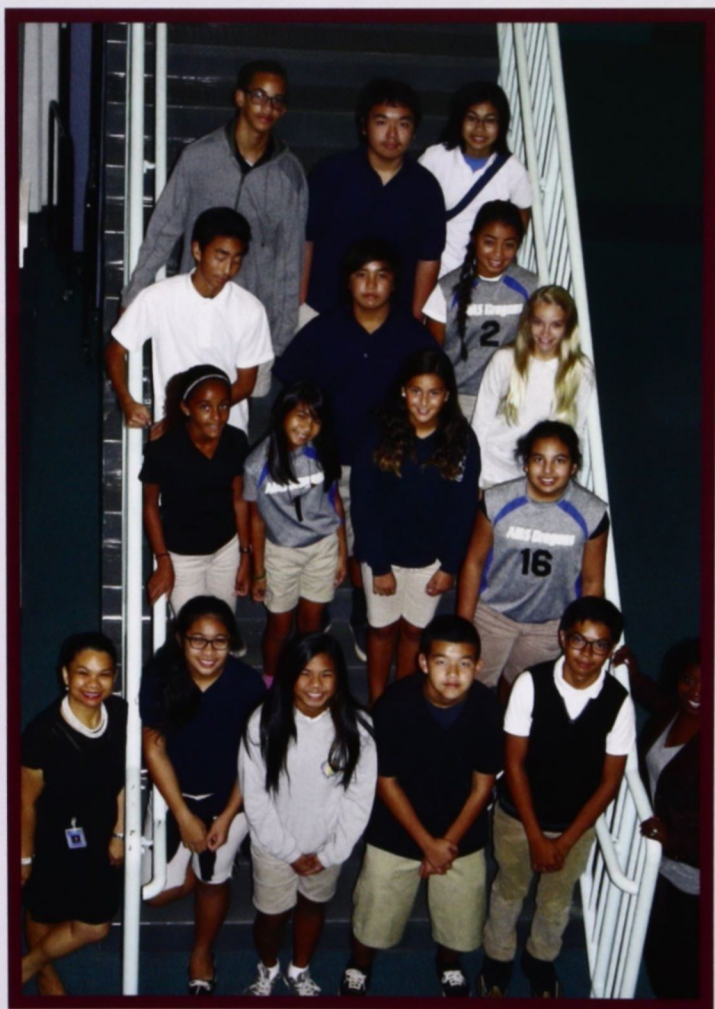


The top students with NHD topics related to the history of Guam competed in the regional competition against other middle schools around the island.

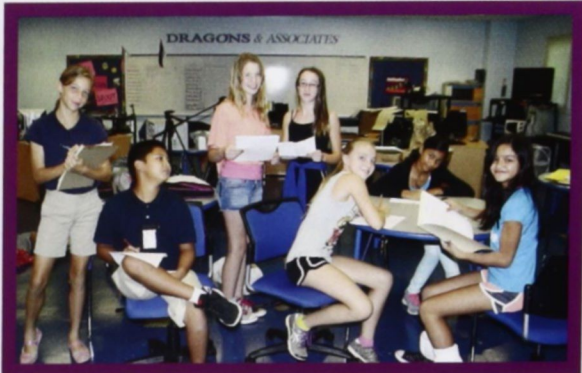
