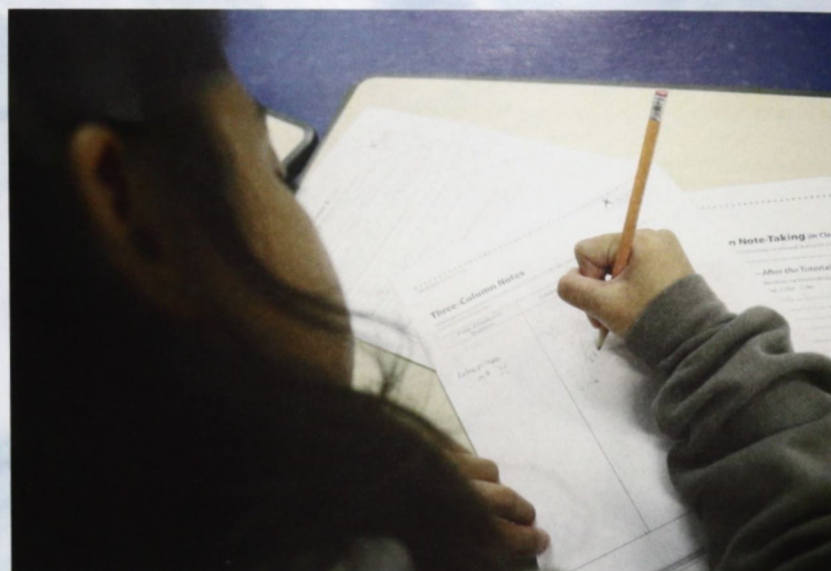

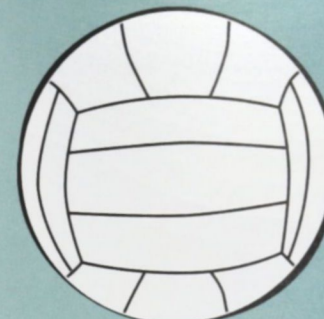

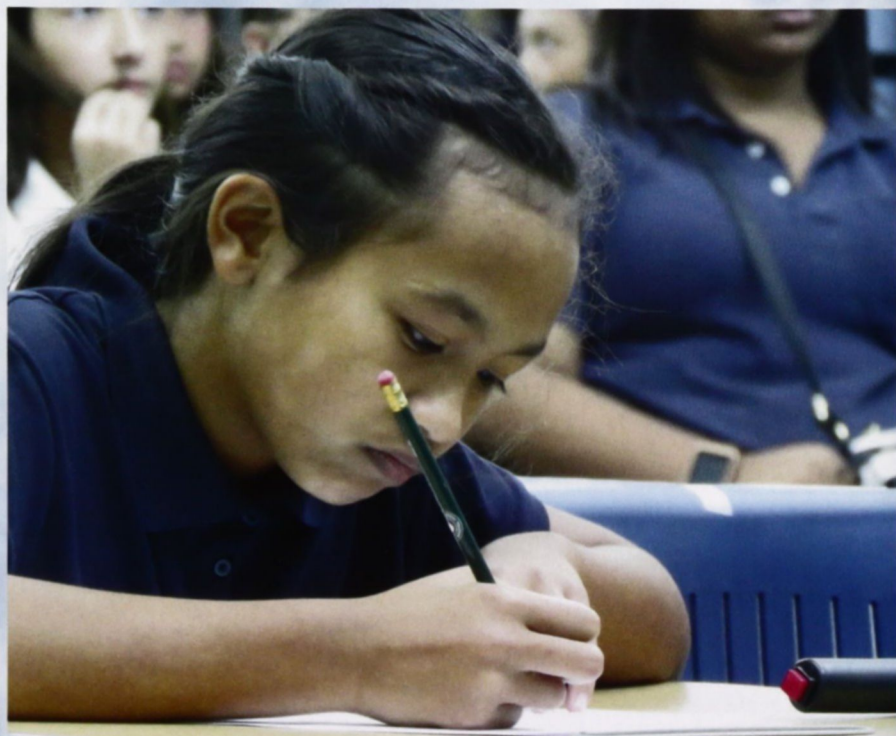

The Many Unique Animals That Live on Guam

Guam is a small U.S territory in the middle of the Pacific Ocean south of Japan and is part of the chain of islands known as the Marianas.

The Black Drongo is a common bird that has a bad reputation for dive-bombing people who get too close to their nest. It is also an invasive species.



The Brown Tree Snake is a invasive species on Guam. It has killed of many of the endemic birds and animals. One animal that it caused to be endangered is the Ko'Ko' Bird.



Paper wasps or "Boonie Bees" are common in the jungles on Guam. They are very territorial and sting anyone unlucky enough to disturb their small hives.

The Coconut Crab is a large terrestrial crab that, as its name suggests, eats coconuts and other small creatures. It is generally a peaceful creature but will defend itself when it is threatened.



The Mangrove Monitor Lizard can grow up to 4 feet in length. They are mainly terrestrial lizards that feed on eggs and smaller animals but some eat fruit and nuts.



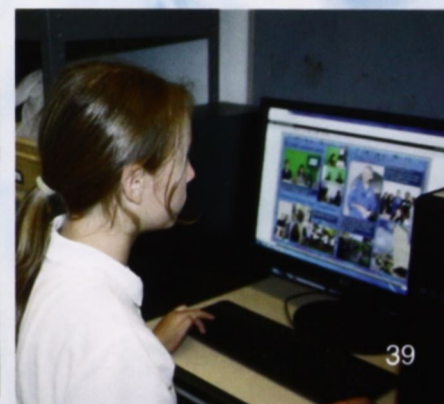
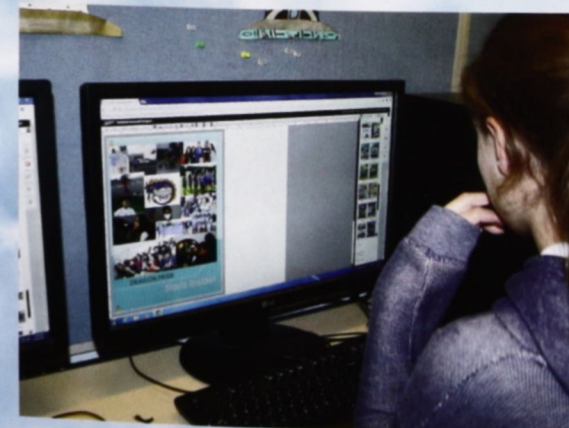
