# FROM ONE SORT OF FIREWORKS TO ANOTHER THE 1990-1991 SCHOOLYEAR IN REVIEW

## GERMAN REUNIFICATION

*"What for most people had been only a dream has become reality."*

—Lothar de Maiziere, (Former) Prime Minister of East Germany

On October 4, 1990, after more than 45 years of division, the 78 million citizens of East and West Germany were reunited as a single nation. German reunification came in the wake of the opening of the Berlin Wall on November 9, 1989 and signalled a true end to Cold War antagonism between NATO and the Eastern Bloc. The union of the two Germanies was celebrated across Germany, with fireworks, parties, and throngs of people gathering in the streets.

Reunification has not been without problems. East German unemployment is high, and inefficiency in factories has increased with no governmental regulation. The cost of living has risen for both East and West Germans, and there have been incidents of racial violence involving East German Skinheads and various ethnic populations settled in Germany. However, despite all its difficulties, united Germany is certain to become a major power in Europe and the world.

For as long as any student in this school can remember, Margaret Thatcher has been synonymous with Great Britain. However, on Thursday, November 22, 1990, this mental association was shattered with the resignation of Thatcher as Prime Minister of England.

Thatcher had been losing the support of the Tory party for months before her resignation. Opinions differed on how closely Britain should be tied to the European Community, and the widespread dissatisfaction among Brits with the (then) new poll tax made the time ripe for a leadership challenge.

Michael Heseltine called for a vote of confidence which produced no clear results. Because Thatcher lacked the support necessary to win a re-vote, she formally resigned her post and withdrew from the competition for party leader. The fight was then between Heseltine, Peter Hurd (the Foreign Secretary), and John Major, the most obscure of the three.

When the votes had been tallied, the dark horse candidate, John Major was declared the new primer Minister of Great Britain. Major, the son of a trapeze artist, had succeeded in ousting one of modern history's most influential female politicians. Although Major's foreign policy is in the same vein as Thatcher's, Maggie's exit from Number Ten, Downing Street after eleven and a half years of residency signals the end of an era.

## OPERATION DESERT STORM

For students living in Turkey, Desert Shield and, later, Desert Storm, were events which could not be easily ignored. On August 2, 1990, Saddam Hussein ordered an Iraqi military invasion of the neighboring emirate of Kuwait, plunging the Middle East into yet another political crisis. Within the next few months, the United States, with support from England, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Turkey, and the United Nations, began a military build-up in Saudi Arabia. While the threat of war was first used as a bluff to scare Hussein out of Kuwait, this notion soon took on a more serious nature. After much debate, the U.N. agreed to set January 15 as the date by which Hussein had to pull out of Kuwait. As most of us (hopefully) know, this deadline was ignored, and action was taken against Iraq.

The Allied offensive began as an air raid on Baghdad, which totalled the city. The barrage of explosives knocked out bridges, roads, and power, water, and communication lines. Iraq retaliated by attacking Israel with S.C.U.D. missiles, with the hope of forcing Israeli involvement in the war, thereby dividing the Allied Coalition. This did not occur, and the U.S. even managed to stop quite a few S.C.U.D.s with the now famous Patriot missiles (a.k.a. the Scudbusters), which, incidentally, cashed in at one million dollars each.

On January 21, Hussein appalled many world leaders by airing videotapes with messages for Allies P.O.W.s who, in the eyes of many, appeared beaten and drugged. This went against a very strict rule regarding the treatment of prisoners of war set down in the Geneva Convention, and Saddam Hussein could be looked upon officially as a war criminal.

Six days later, the general animosity felt by many towards Hussein was increased when the madman dumped millions of gallons of oil into Persian Gulf waters. When asked to comment on this act, President Bush coined the phrase "environmental terrorism" as a name for Saddam's action.

Soon after, another deadline was announced. The Allies had withheld land combat for more than four weeks, but if Saddam had not begun a noticeable withdrawal from Kuwait by high noon, February 24, the Allied forces would commence a ground war. Thus began the 100 hour war. Saddam's forces offered little resistance, often surrendering to Allied troops willingly. It was one of the easiest victories in the history of American military engagements.

By February 28, the Stars and Stripes emblazoned the headline, "Allies Liberate Kuwait", and news of the ceasefire was heard around the globe. Spirits were high everywhere, and the press conference which featured General "Stormin' Norman" Schwarzkopf, was viewed by many with joy and relief. Eventually, Soldiers would be able to go home and see their families once more. Specials featuring Bob Hope and other celebrities were festive occasions, and towns held ticker-tape parades for their fighting fellow Americans.

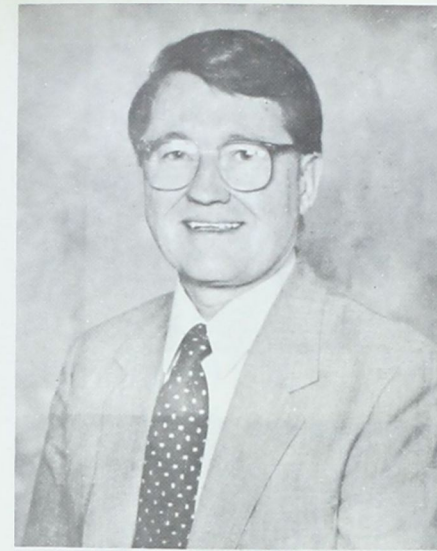
While the war affected many all over the planet, students in Ankara were particularly aware of the political events. Not only were five days of school cancelled, but exams were delayed as well (too bad!). Some of the minor effects of the war that were less favorable were the cancellations of road trips and school buses. However, Trojans took all of this in their stride, happy with the knowledge that they could say, years from now, "I got out of school for a week 'cause of the war!"
