


A majority of the department coordinators felt that option #2 was the most workable solution.



VARSITY BASKETBALL


Although the Ansbach Cougars did not have a winning season, we had a swell time playing the game. The Cougars basketball record was 2-12.






















JV BASKETBALL











GOLF


GIRLS VOLLEYBALL

NEWSPAPER


The Cougar's Corner of Ansbach American High School set high standards and goals for the 1974-75 school year.

or be entertained by Abraxas . . . ,






STUDENT COUNCIL
