




2. Alter our schedule for dismissal at 1515. (Also perhaps alter Ansbach Elementary Schedule.)


A majority of the department coordinators felt that option #2 was the most workable solution.




Returning to head Ansbach American High School in his second year as principal, Mr. Rex Burgett continued to enforce policies introduced at his arrival and the opening of our school last year.


Aiding Mr. Burgett, also for the two years of our existence, Mr. Milton Alexander has maintained the role of overseeing the acquisition of supplies.


1974 Football Season






Although the Ansbach Cougars did not have a winning season, we had a swell time playing the game. The Cougars basketball record was 2-12.




JV BASKETBALL

The Staff wishes to thank everyone for the help they gave us.




ACTIVITY PERIOD


HUMAN AWARENESS


LETTERMEN'S CLUB





Activities this year included courses on child care, First Aid, and good grooming. Some members assisted the Administration with sitting arrangements for assemblies.



