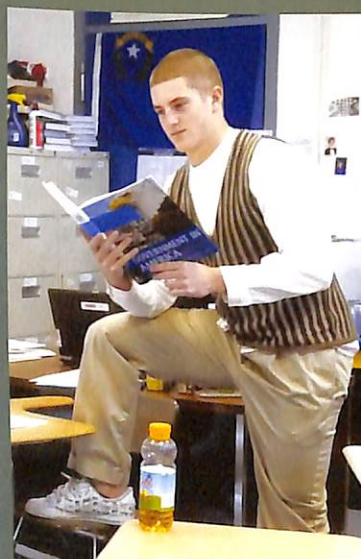

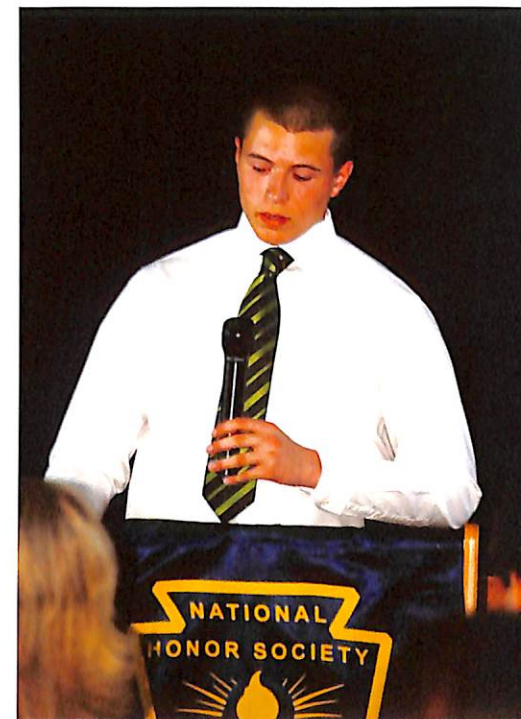

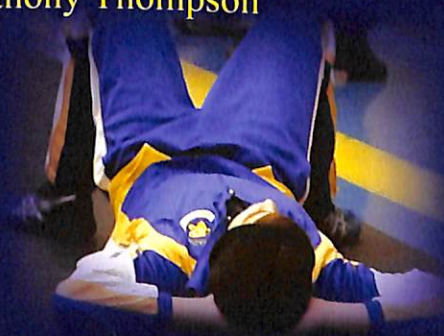

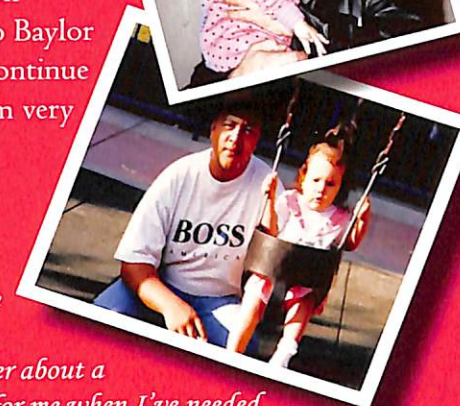
My dear Megan,

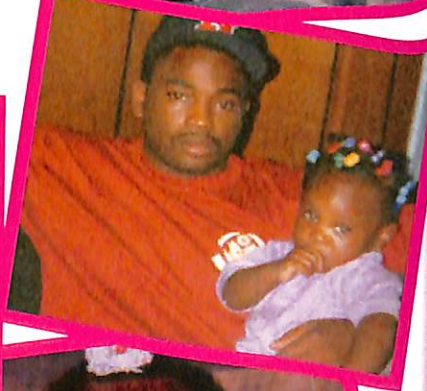
My daughter,
