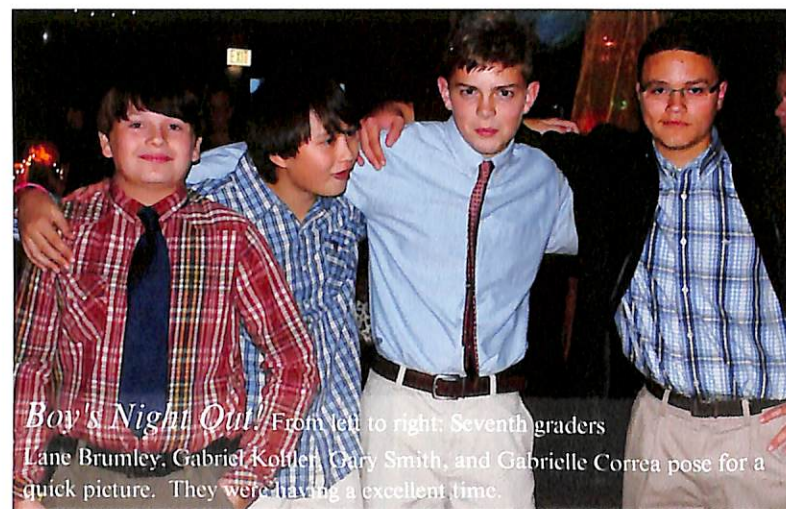

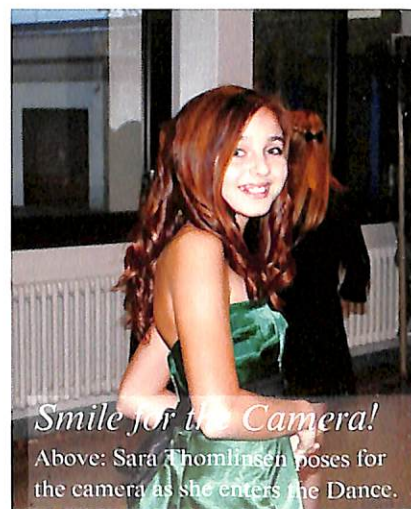

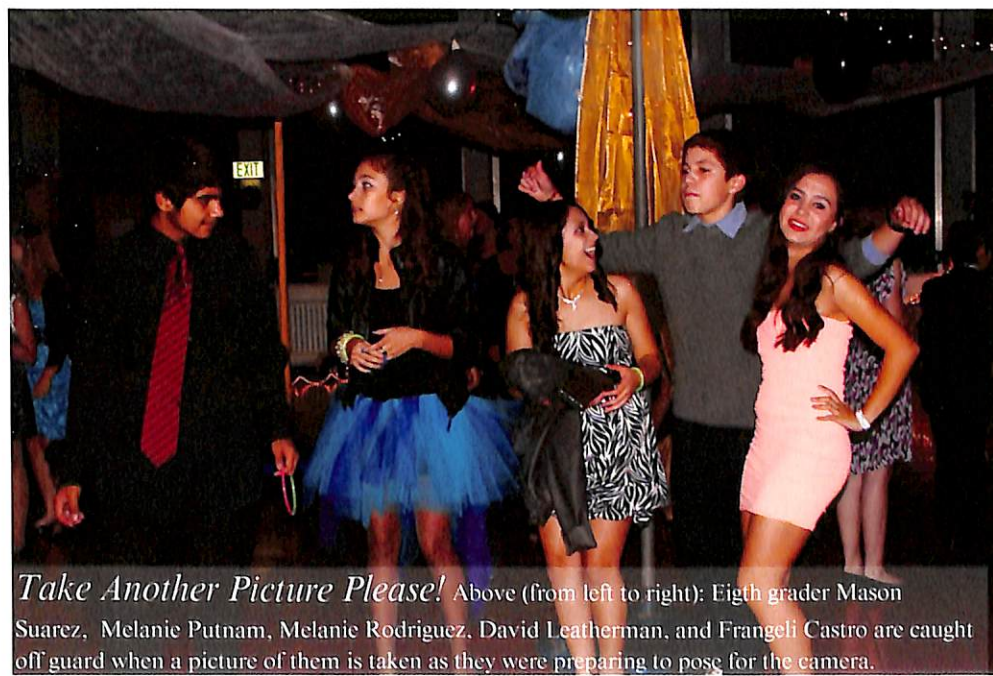

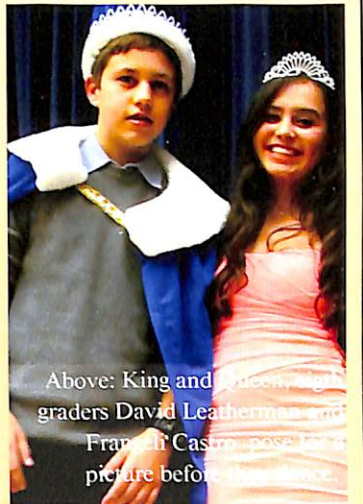

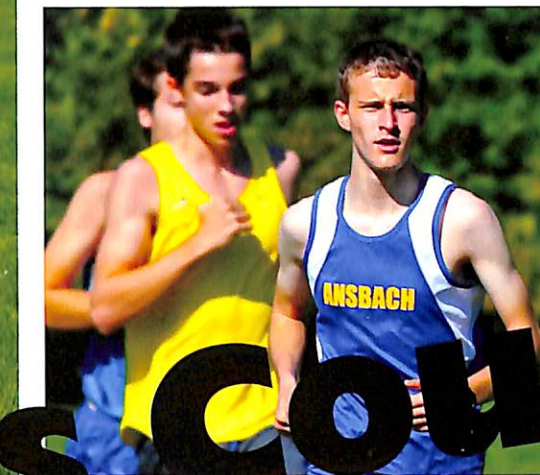

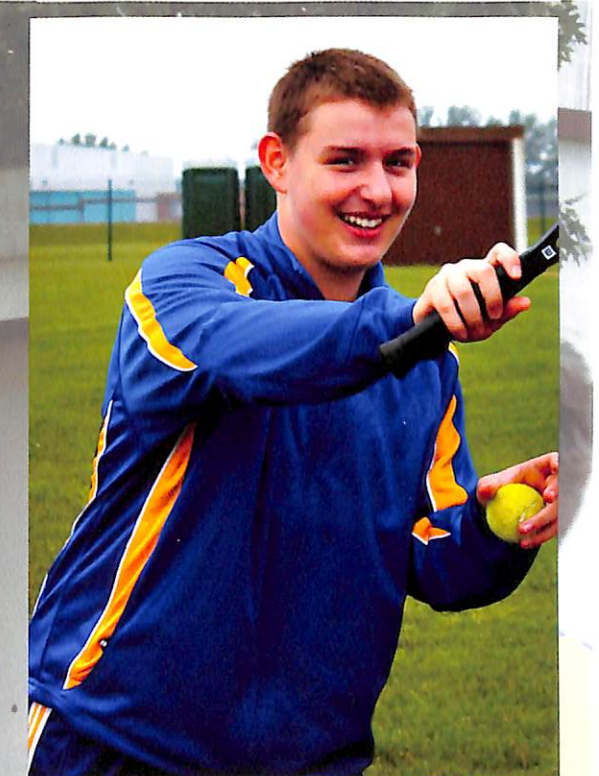
# Tennis

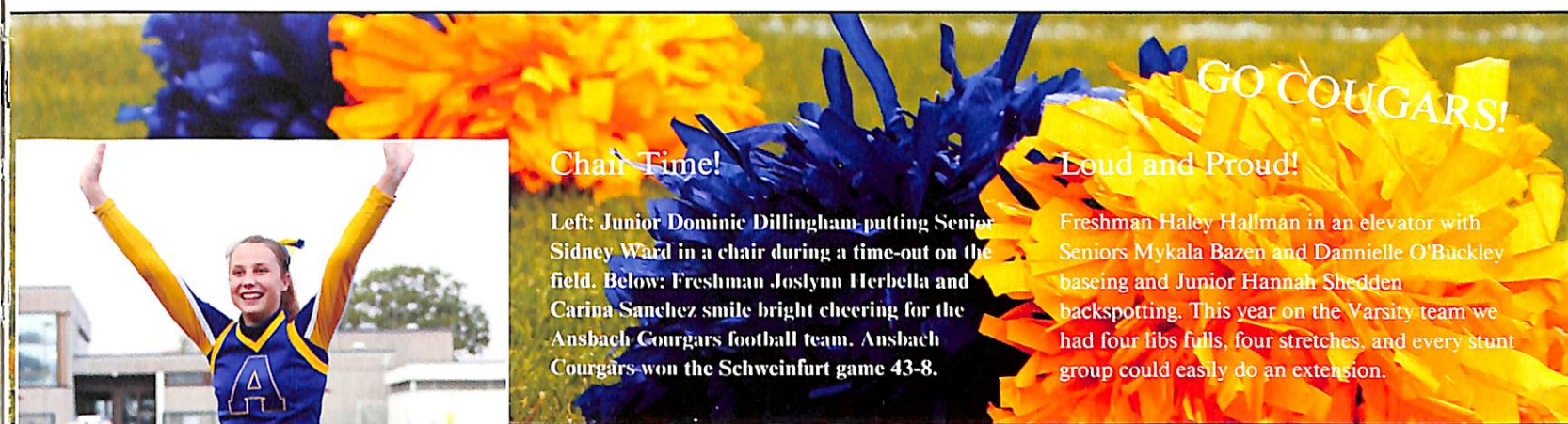

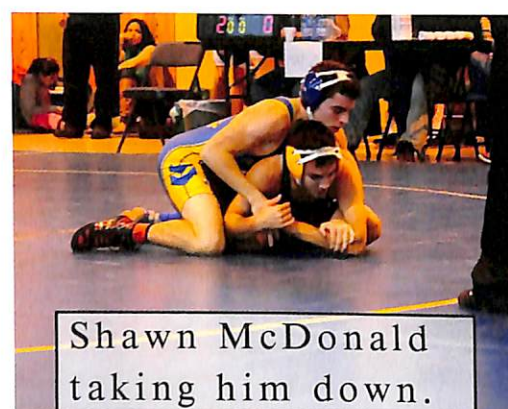

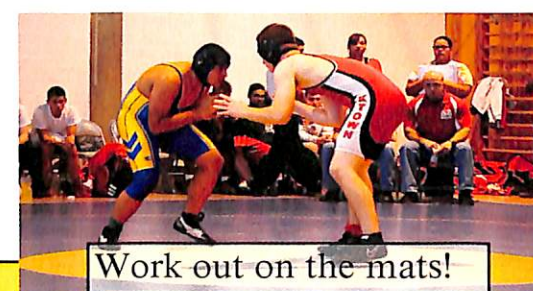

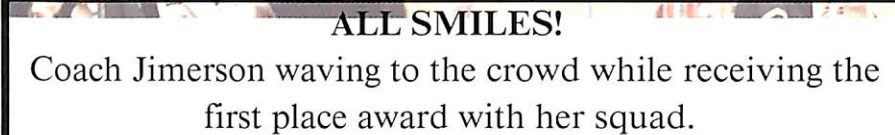

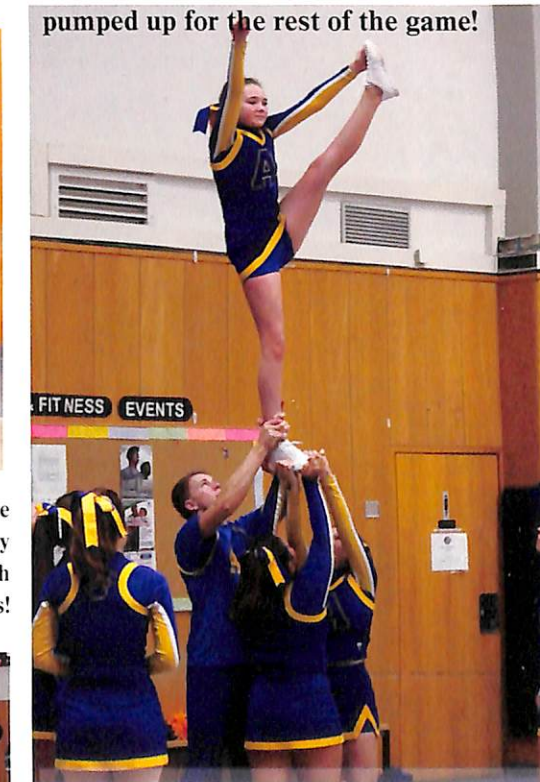

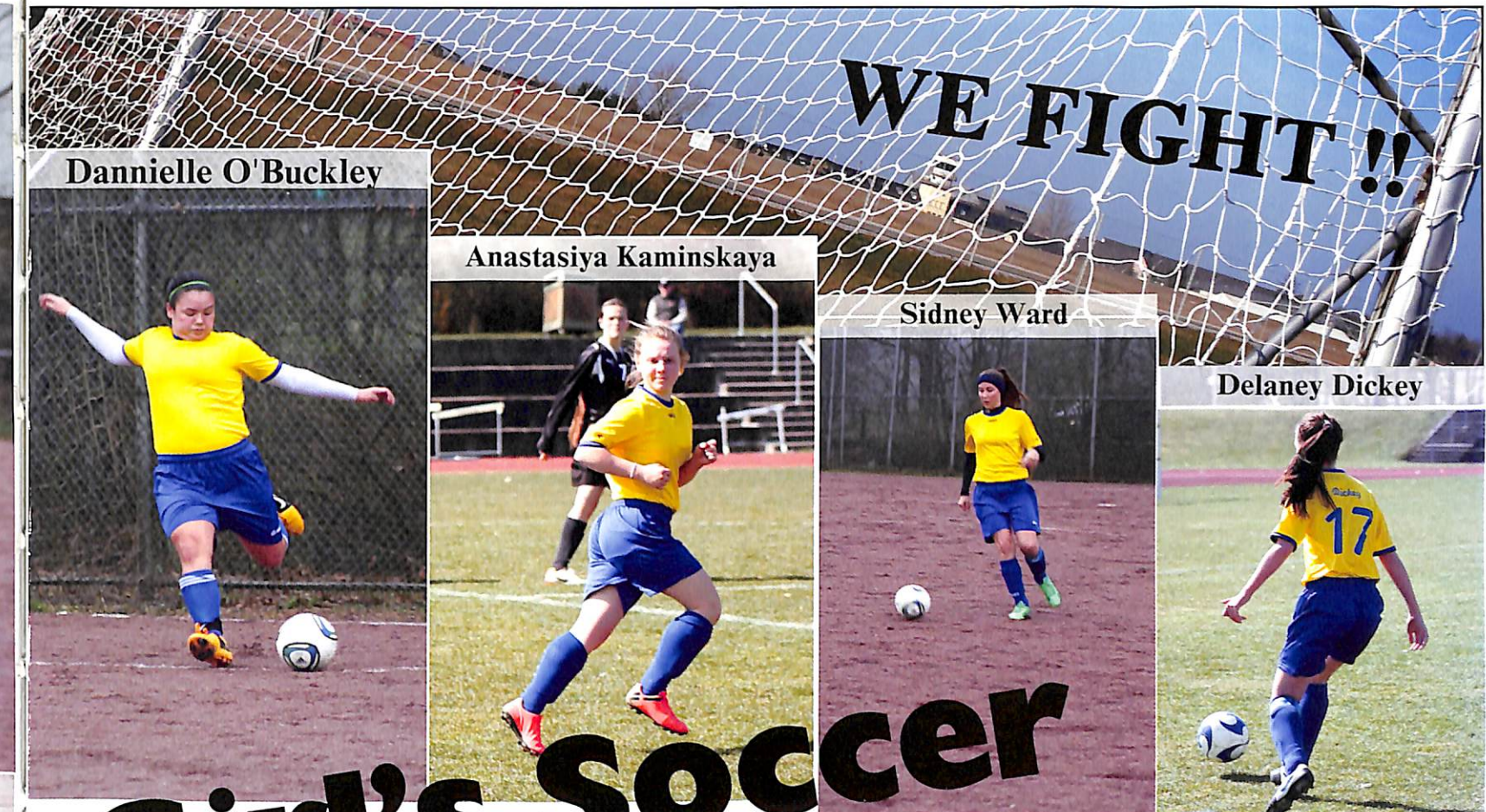

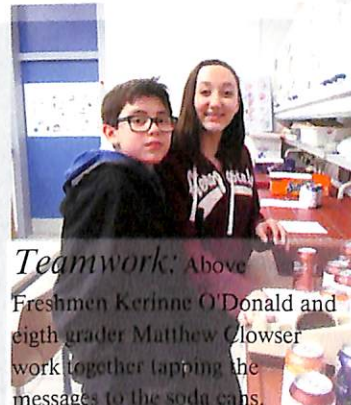

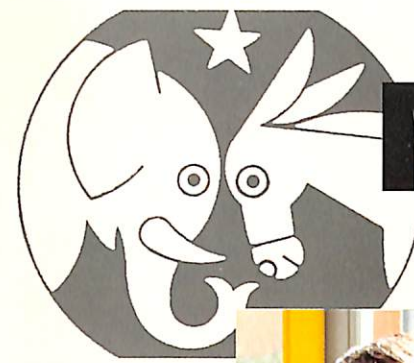

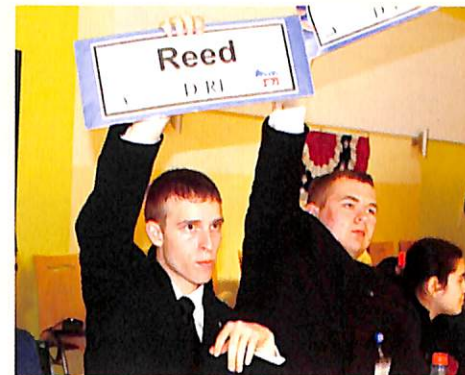

## Traditional Ceremonies: Guest Speaker, Grog Ceremony and Toast, and Cake Cutting Ceremony

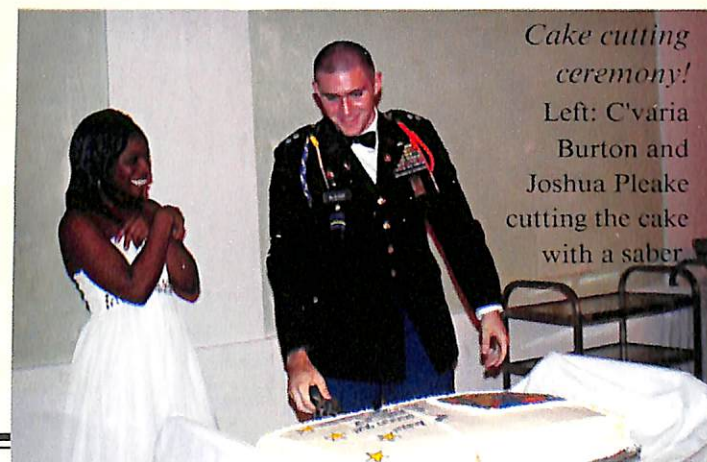

# Rifle team

What is Rifle Team? It is a varsity sport/marksmanship competition on a 10m range. The competition consists of a 6 person team shooting in three positions: prone, standing, and kneeling. Each position is worth 100 points equaling 300 points total. Shooting in the 280's is considered outstanding for an individual and over 1400 for a team. Total team points use the best 5 out of 6 for a final shooters for a final score. It is a team competition with 5 teams in our conference. Ansbach took 1st place in conference and 3rd place in the European championships on February 1, 2014. Brian Sowder, senior, was high shooter taking 5th.

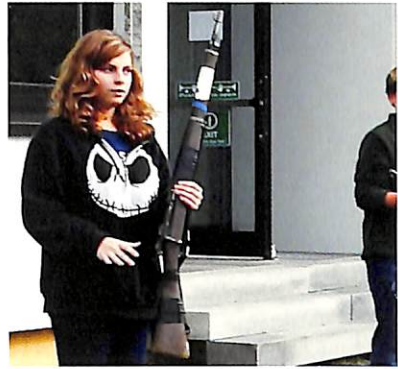
