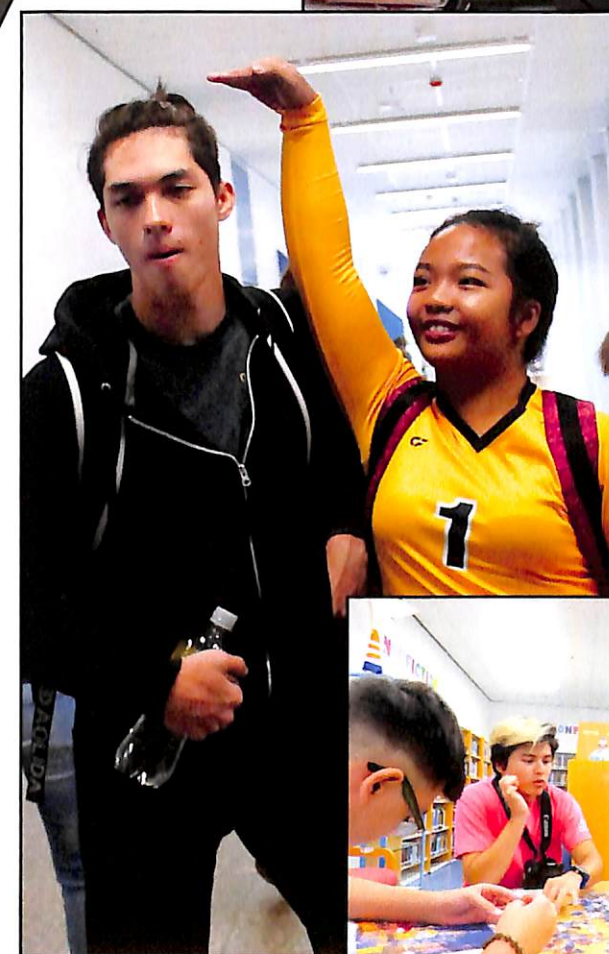

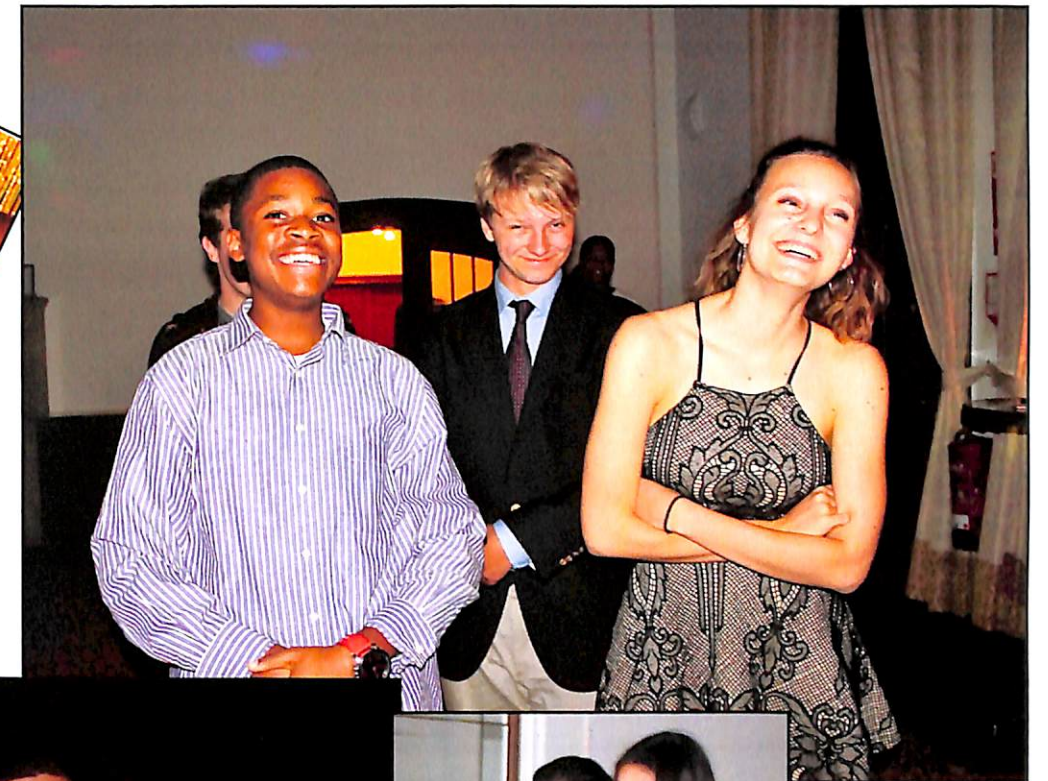

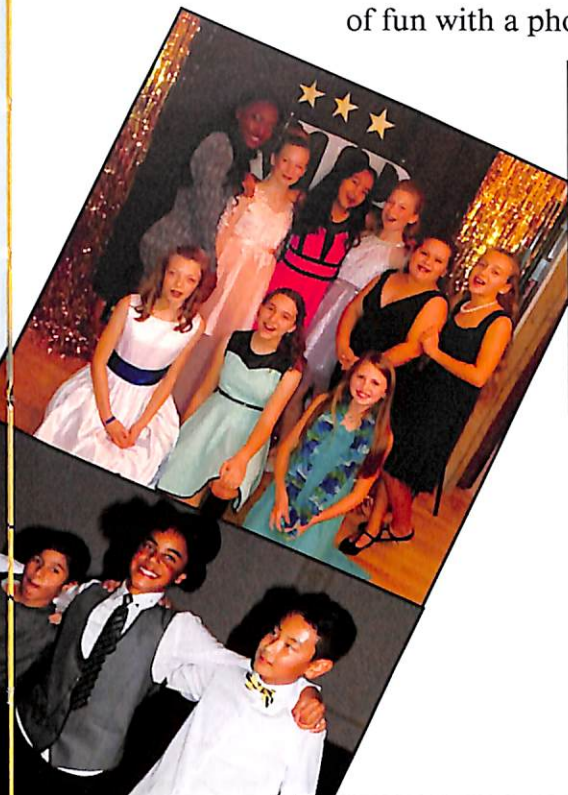

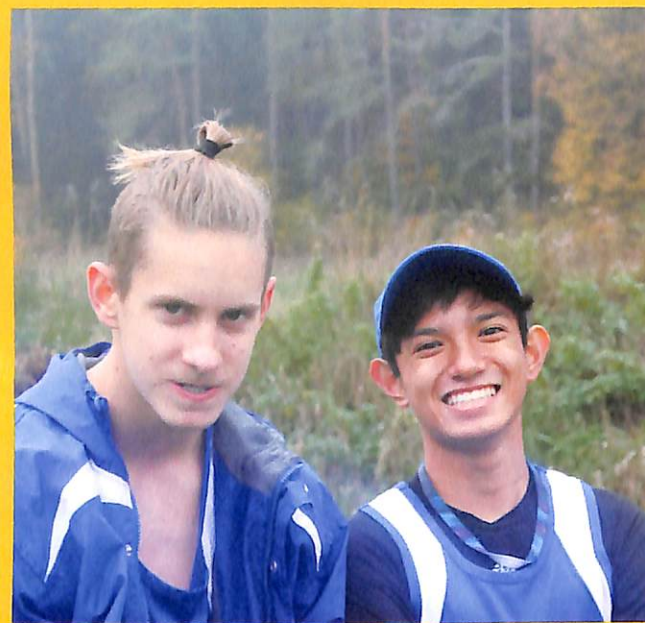

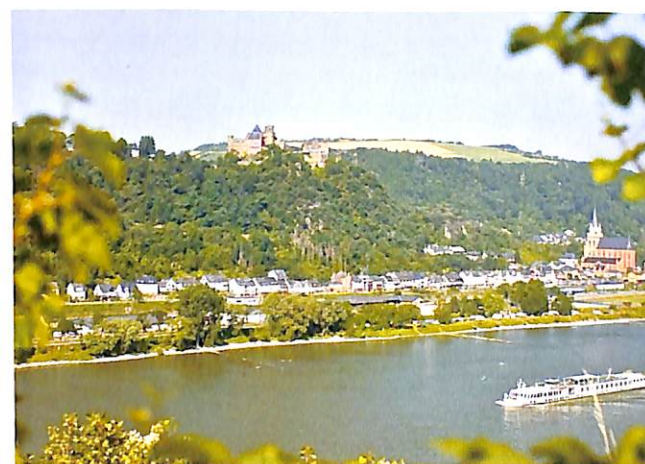

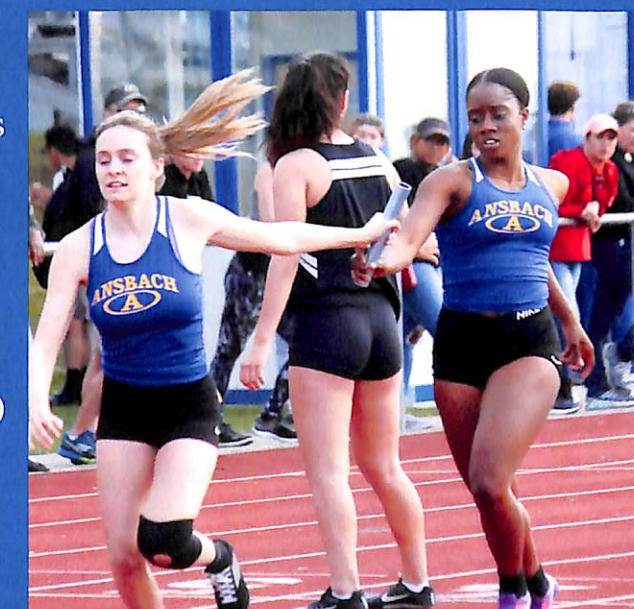
Projected team strengths:

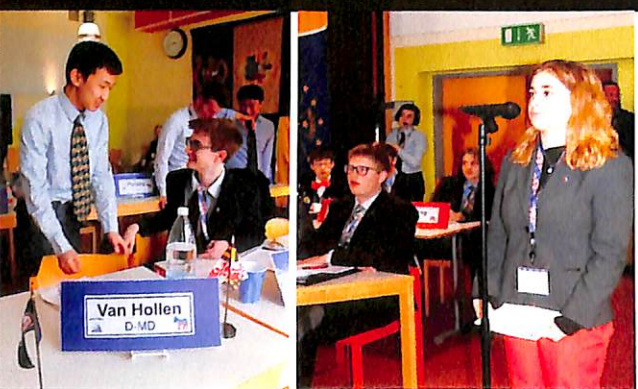
