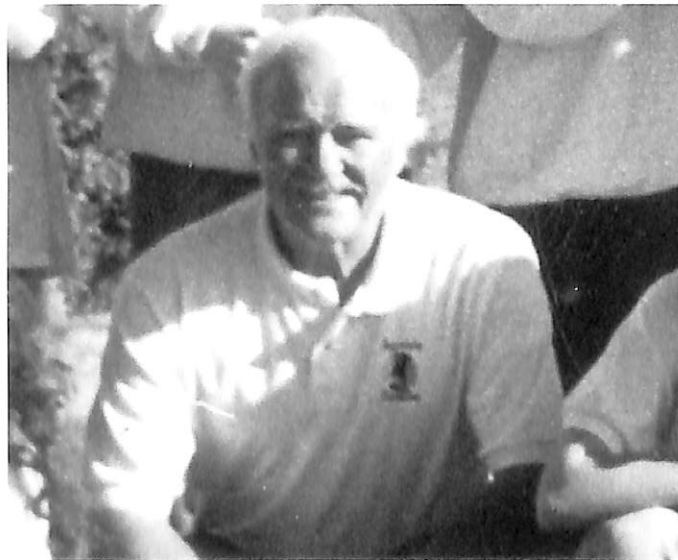


GOLF TEAM WINS IT ALL!

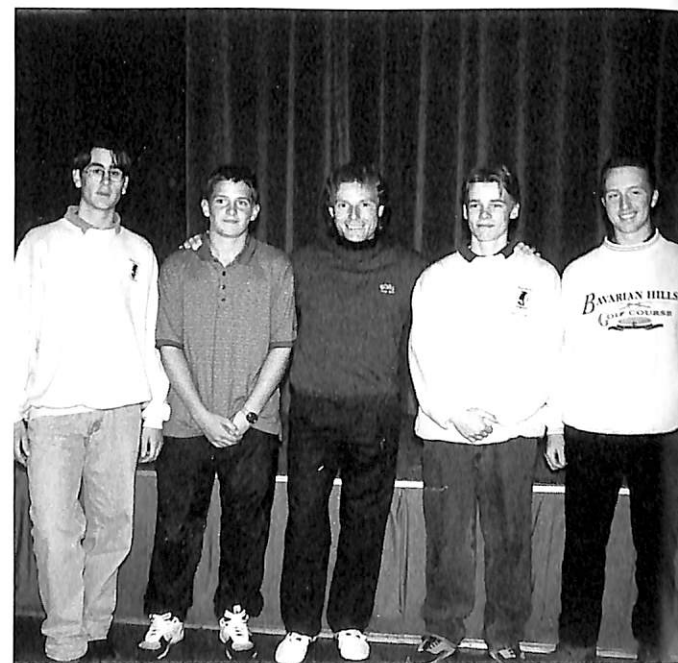
