

Our school magazine, The Seasons, is made up of compositions by members of our school. We use poems, book reviews, short stories and puzzles by the students themselves.


Mr. Rossey, our sponsor, types the magazine and makes sure it gets printed. Without him, we wouldn't have a magazine.
