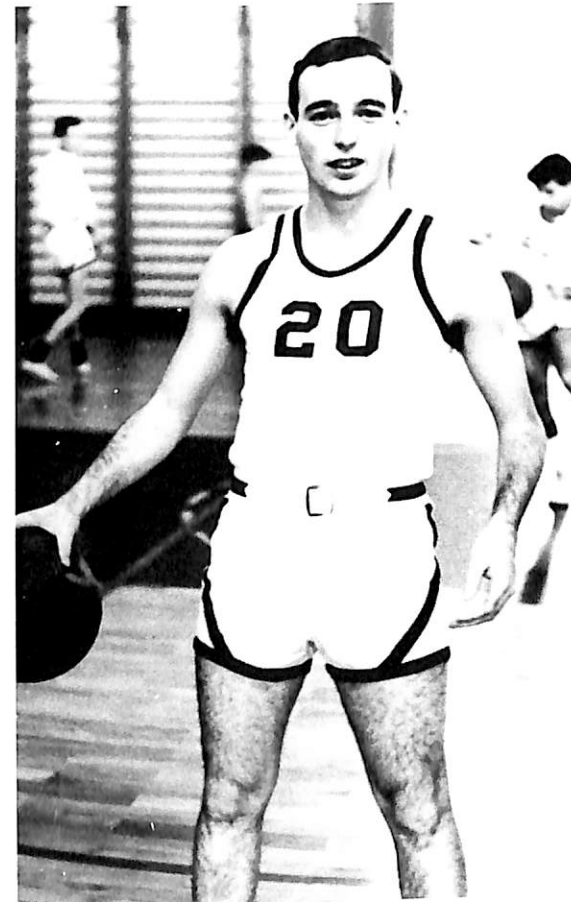
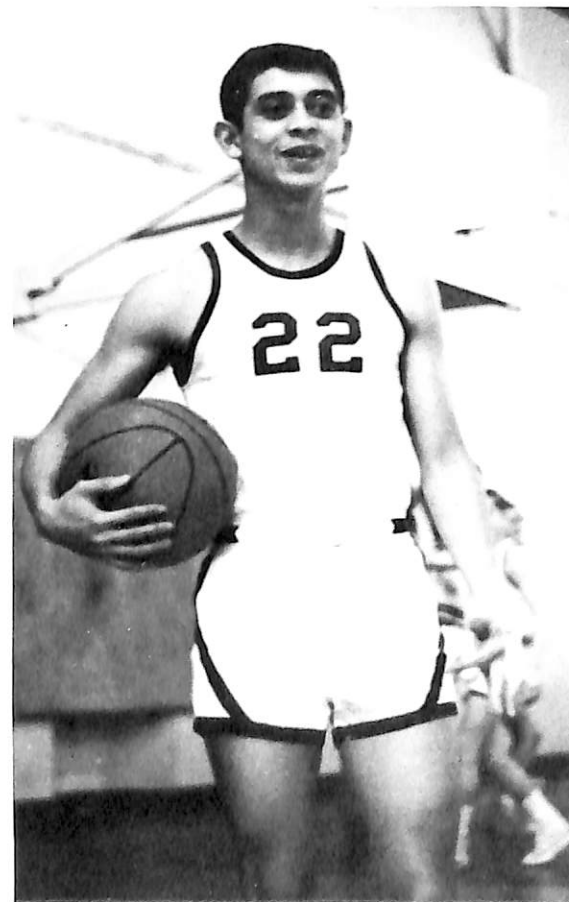
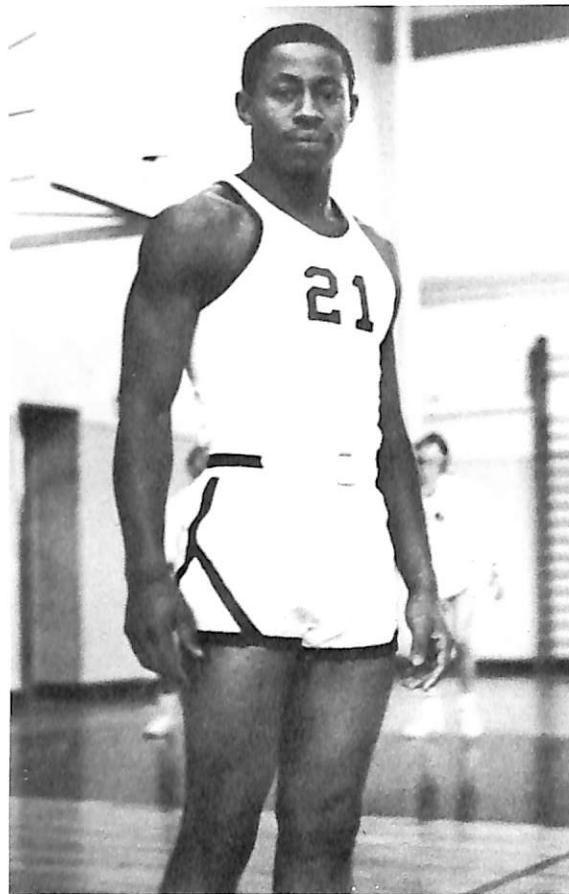


Basketball
