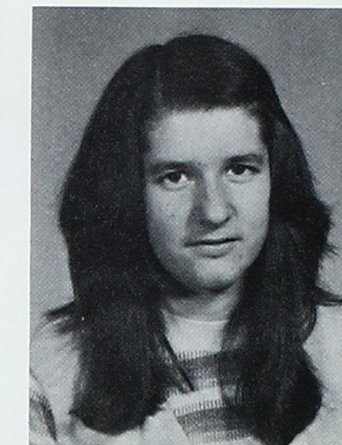
## Freshmen

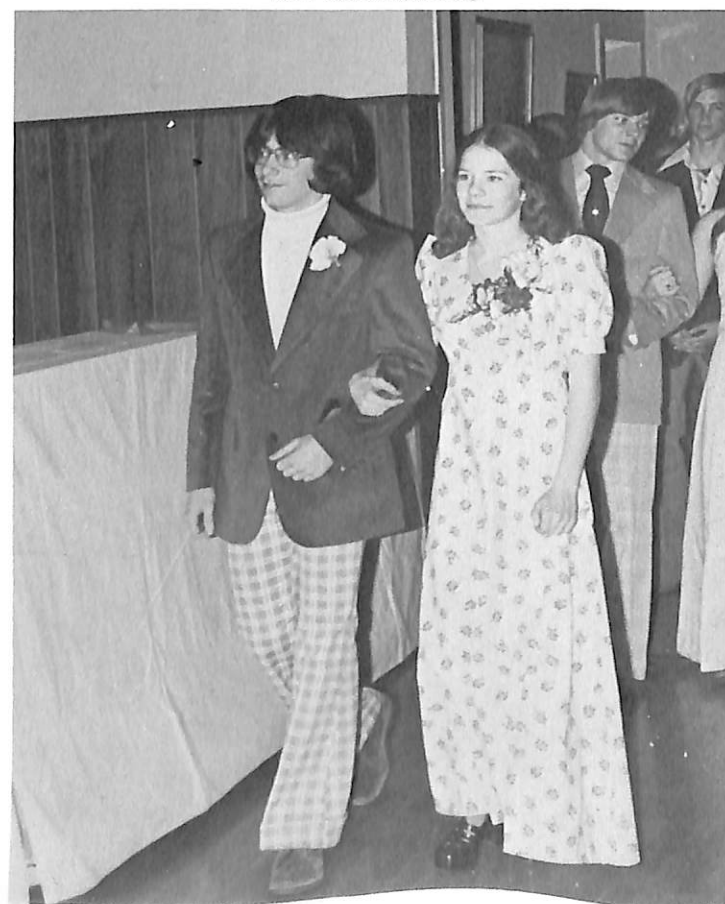


## Winter Homecoming Dance
