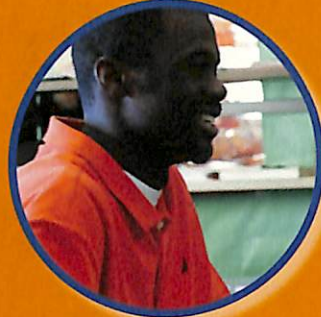
Senior Trip

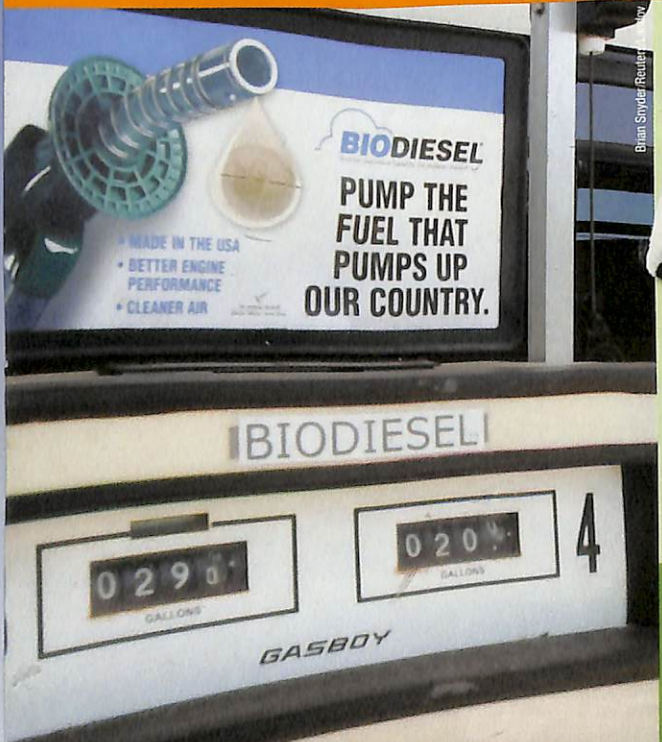
