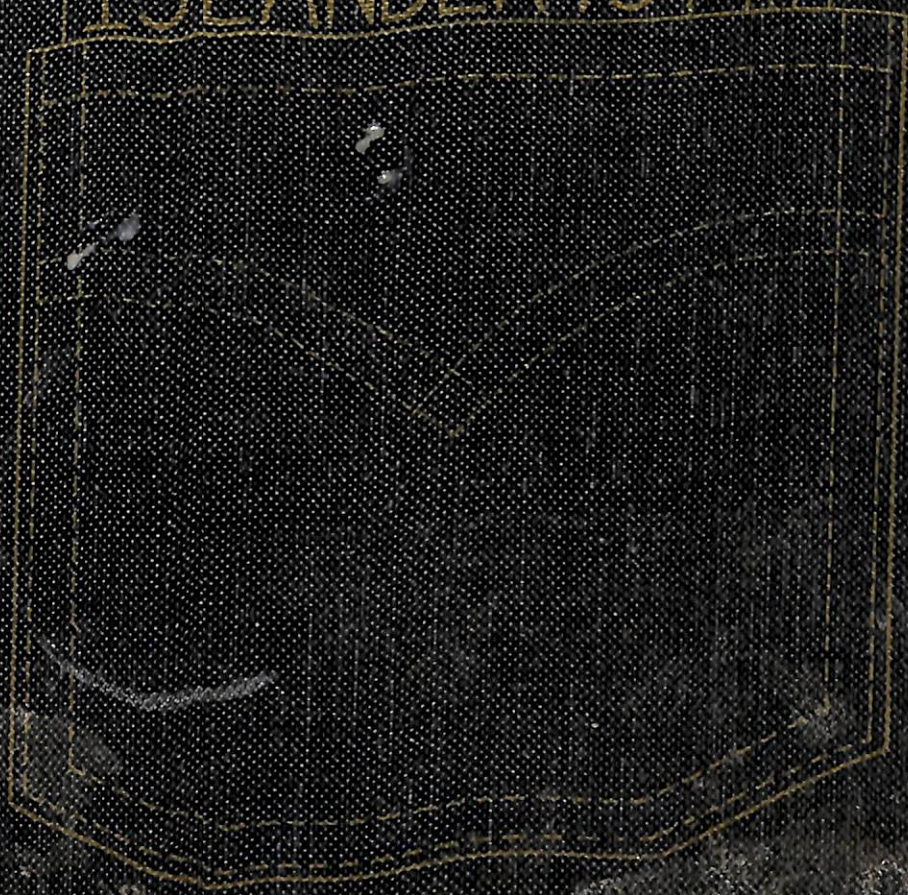

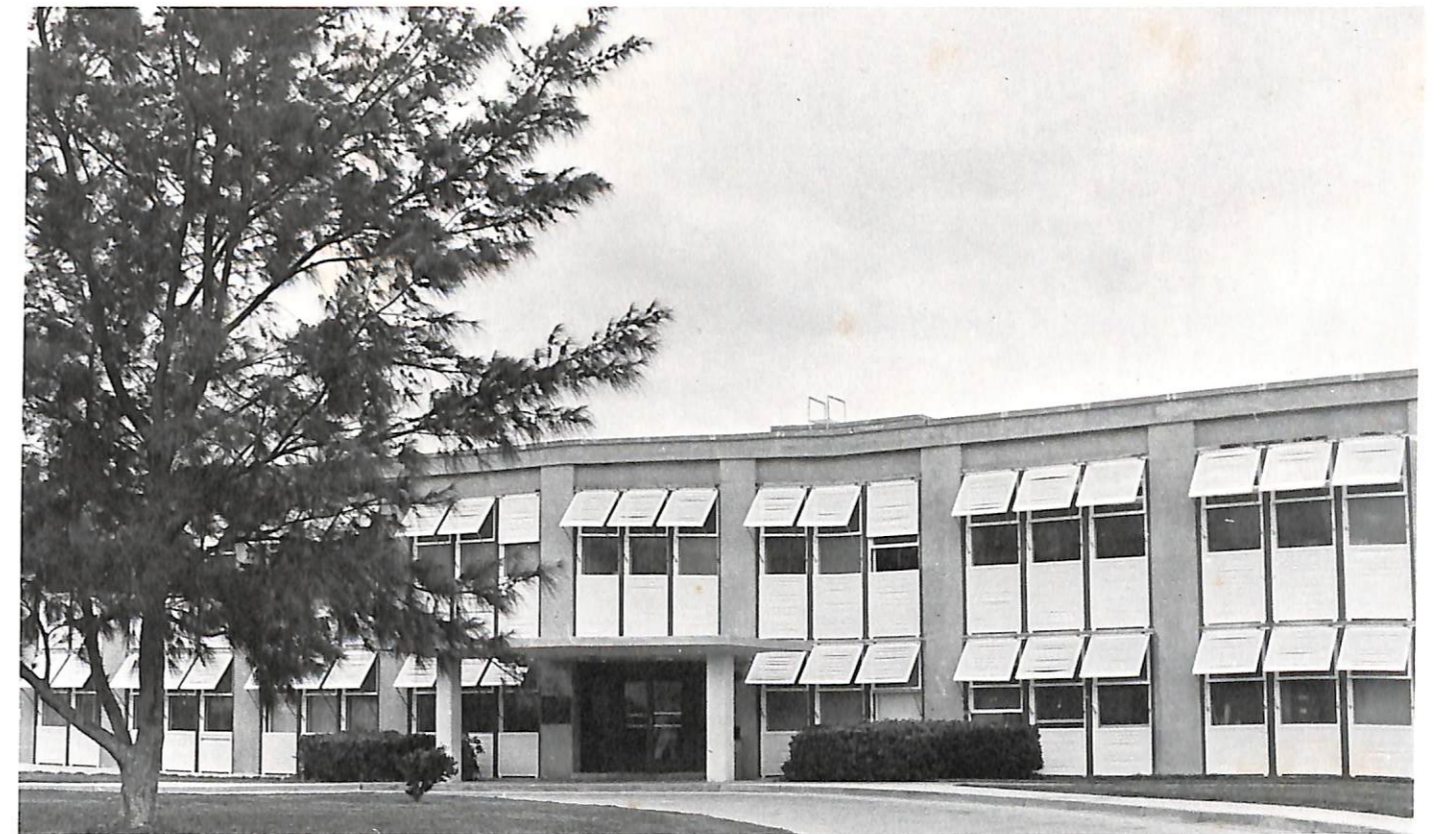

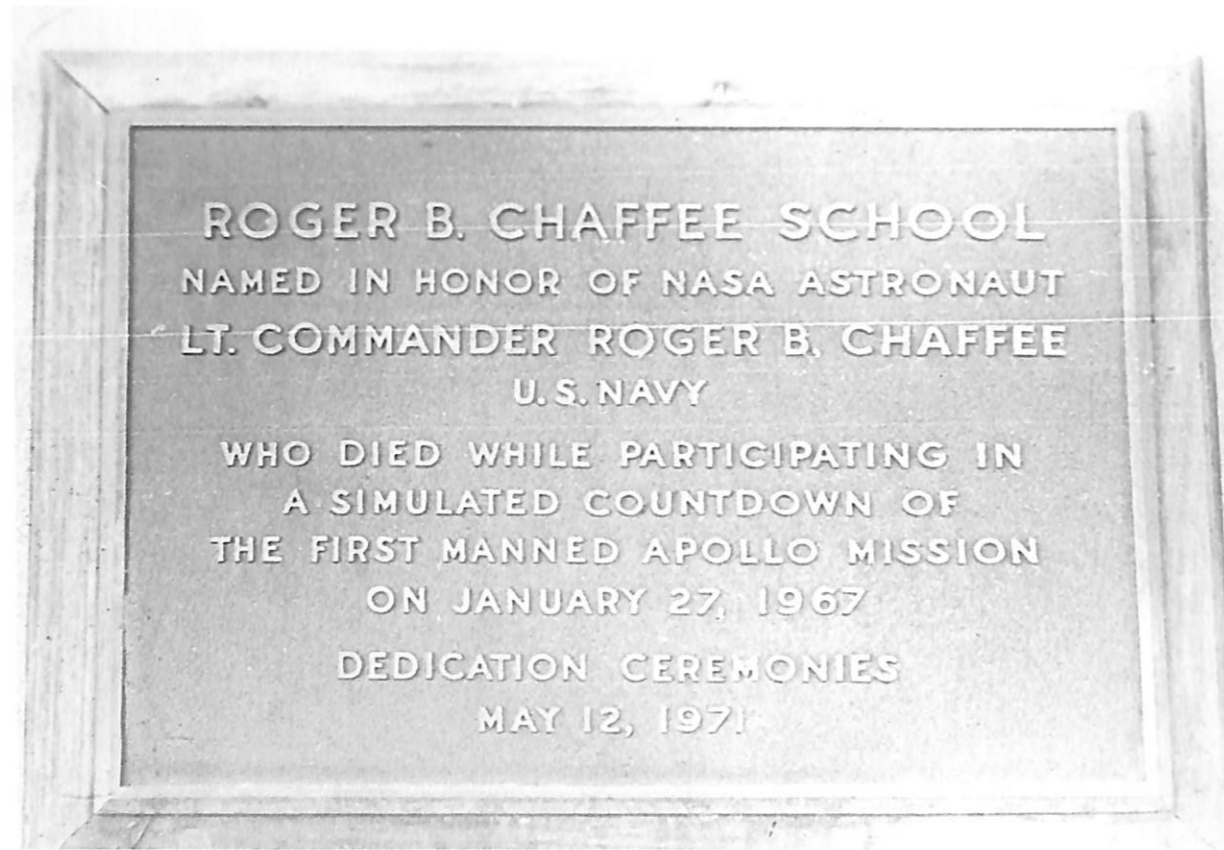


## BERMUDA,
