For the past four months, there have been a number of improvements made at Chaffee High School. The price tag for these accomplishments totals \$750,000.

Much work was done on not only the interior but the exterior. The school's facade was enhanced by the installation of attractive windows. Painting the exterior will soon be done.

In the interior, new tiles for the floor were laid, and painting was done throughout the building. New lockers, a major concern of students in the past, were finally installed. A new supply room, next to the cafeteria, will soon be completed by the Public Works Department.

Other projects projected for the near future include the ordering of window shades. Next summer the installation of new lighting systems and improvements on the ceilings will be done. A contract for an air-conditioned gym, locker rooms, and shop will be made.

## PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE FOR THE YEARBOOK 1988-89

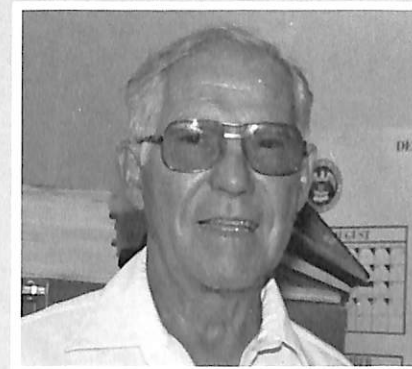
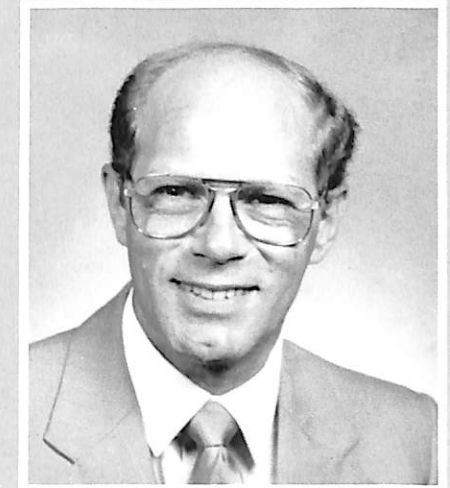
In a very short time, the class of 1989 will finish the last requirements demanded of them for graduation from high school and will embark on the many and varied ventures that await them in their chosen fields.
