We will all remember different things, but some of the most memorable are the school dances, Sports Night, Cirque des Etoiles, the Geography Bee, the Hundred Days Celebration, the sixth grade trip to Italy, the school volksmarch, Field Day. There was something for everyone.

Living overseas provides us with experiences that other kids back home can only dream about. But, with the great times comes the knowledge that we will leave our friends behind when we leave Germany. We will remember them for many years to come, some of them for a lifetime, and this book will help keep their names and faces fresh in our minds.

Mr. Mark Ambelang is our media specialist. He runs the library.




Mr. Leroy Lamotte is our art teacher. He teaches us to express ourselves.

Mr. Richard Williams is our media technician.




Mrs. Heidi Heller is our physical education teacher. She keeps us physically fit!








