SUPERBOWL XLII • The NEW YORK GIANTS (14-6) upset favorite New England Patriots (18-1) to win Super Bowl XLII. Quarterback Eli Manning passed to Plaxico Burress on a 13-yard fade in the final 35 seconds to nail the victory. It was the Giants 11th straight victory on the road, as they became the 1st NFC wild card team to ever win the Super Bowl. The 1972 Miami Dolphins also had reason to celebrate – the Giants win left their record, the only perfect season in the Super Bowl era, intact.

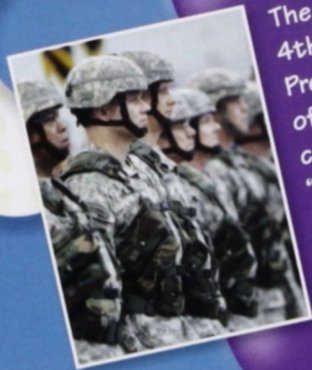

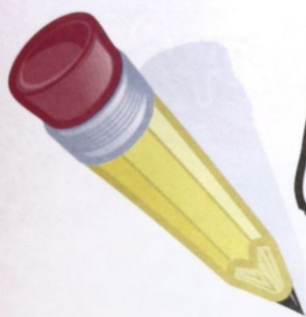

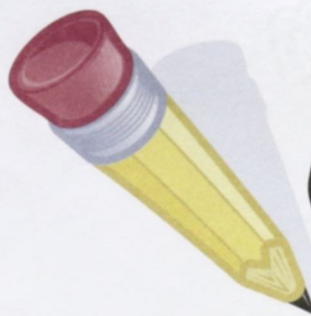
