Chinese Acrobats



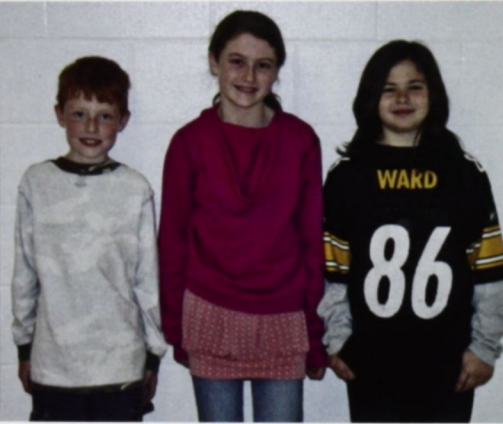
These **Chinese Acrobats** left their home in Beijing to tour the east coast and share their incredible talents of contortion and balance with the students at Bitz. **WOW!!!**

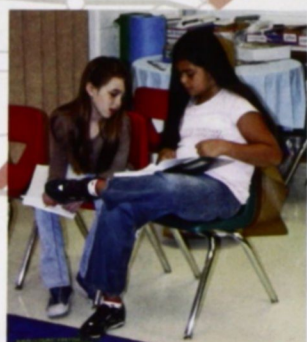
