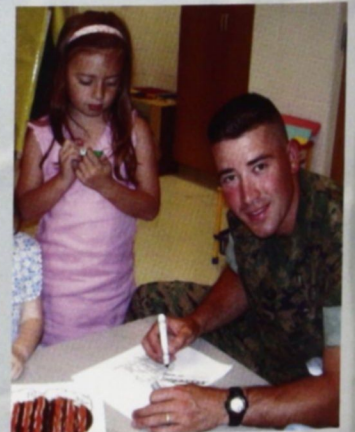




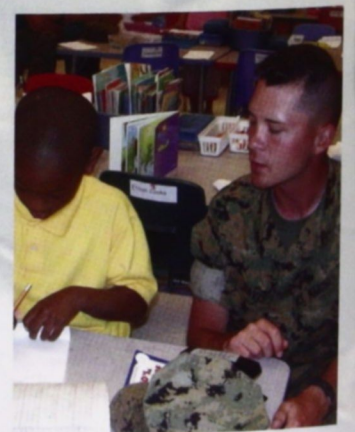
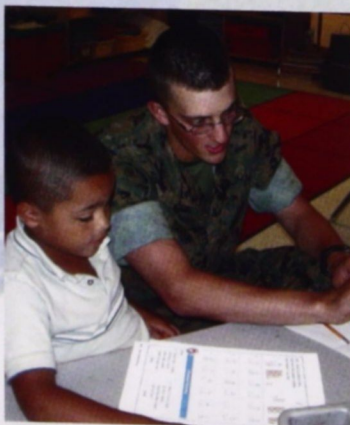
This book is dedicated to all of the Military Volunteers who have spent their time within the walls of Johnson Primary School.

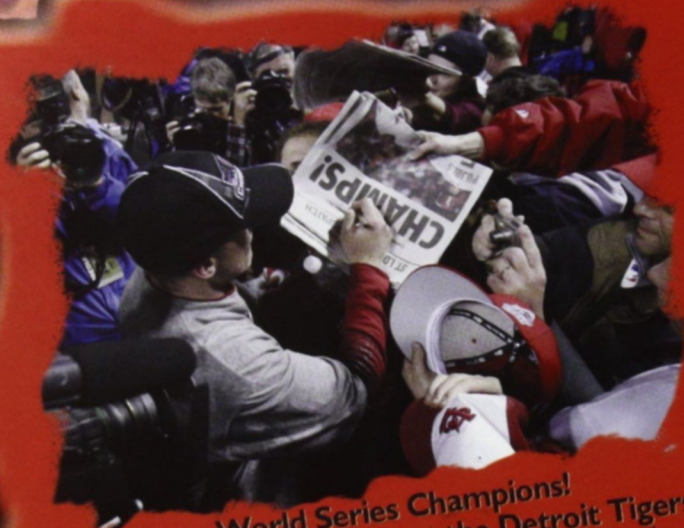

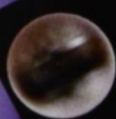

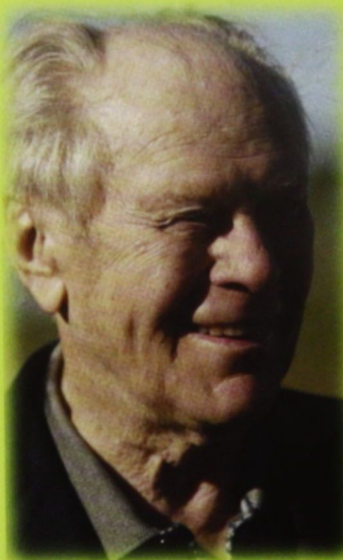

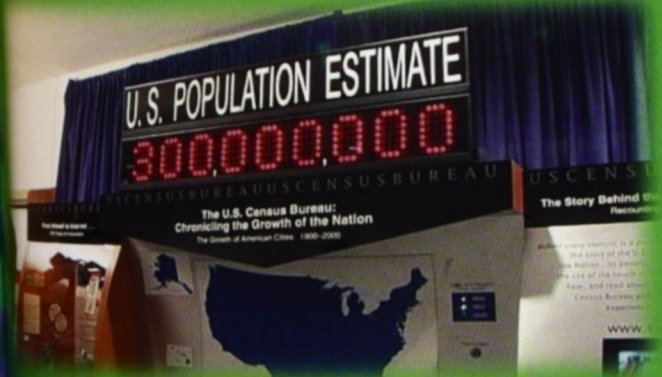

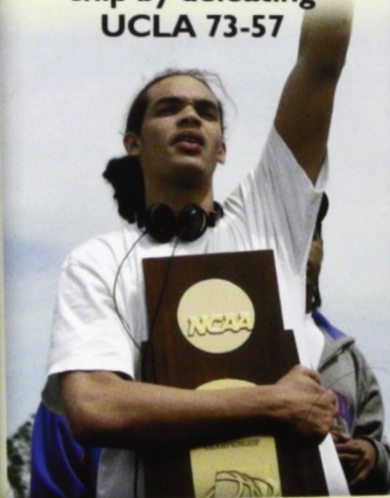

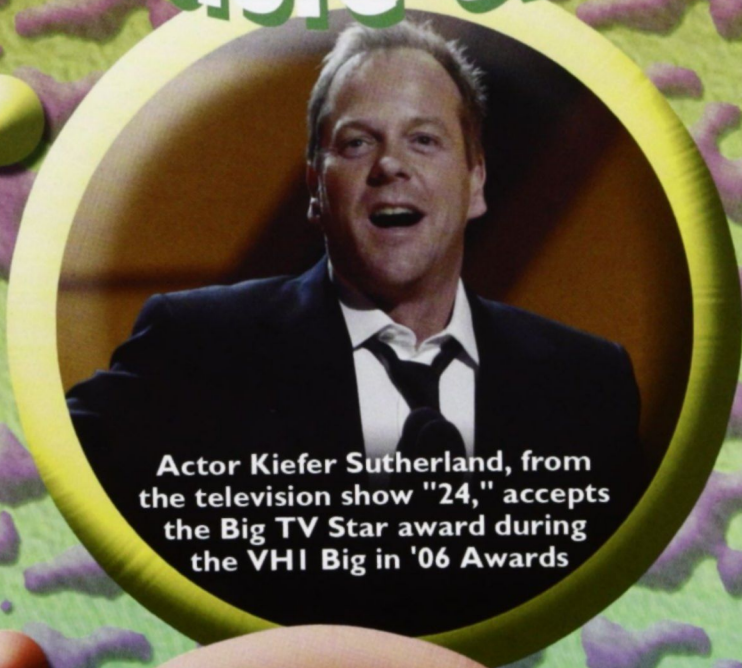

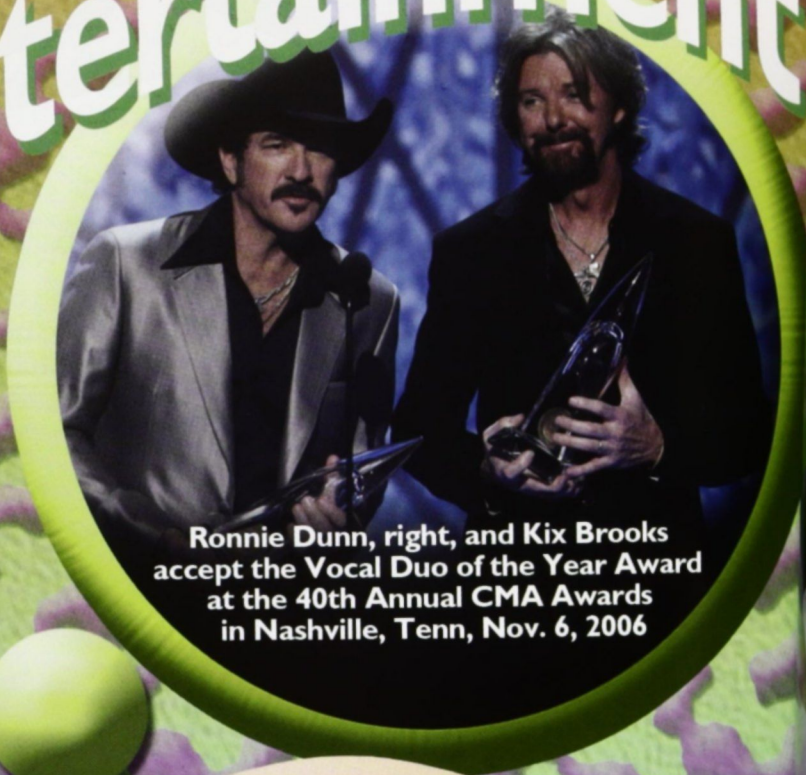

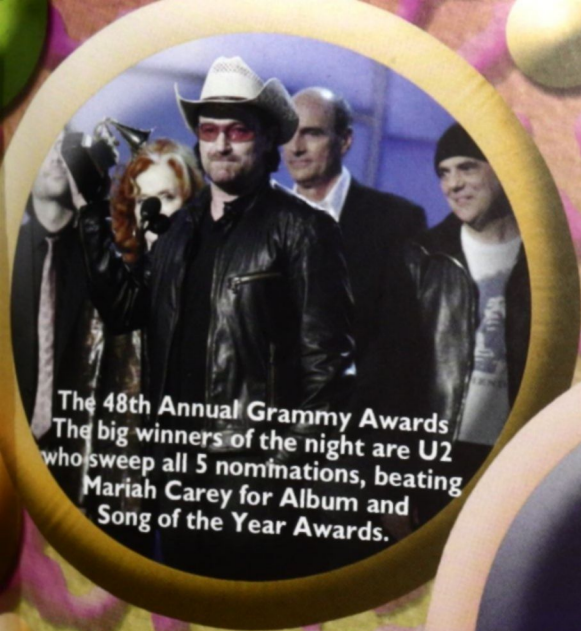

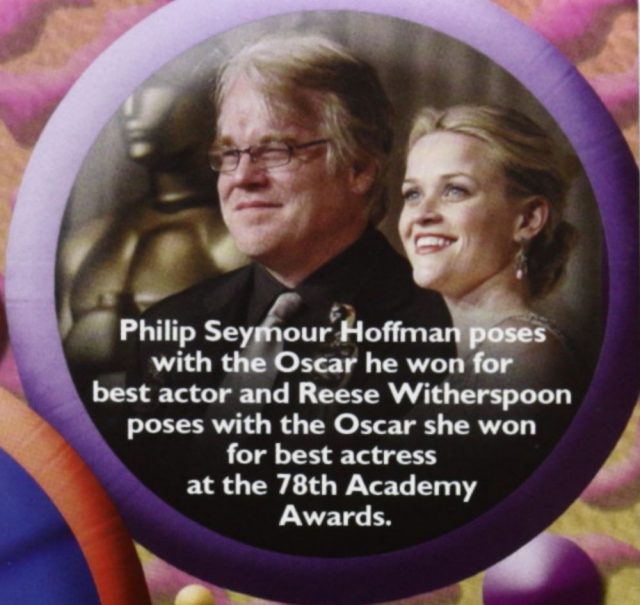
