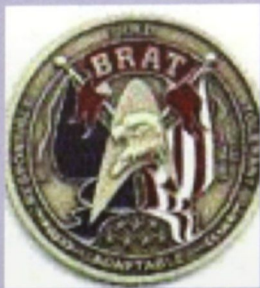

I also know that the other half is waiting to be met.

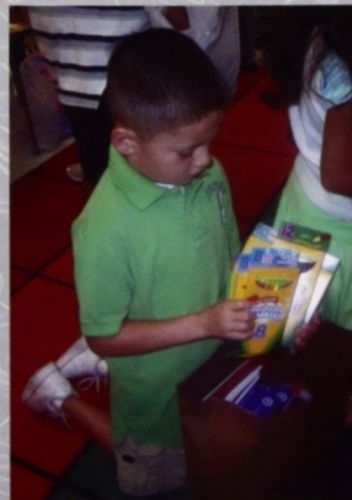
Friendships are formed in hours and kept for decades.

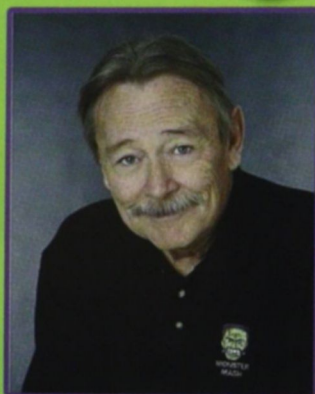

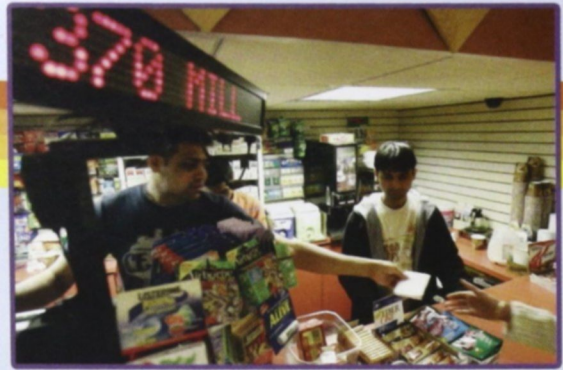

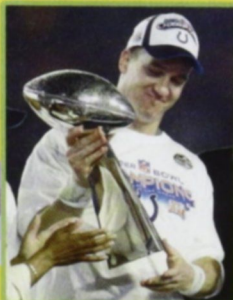

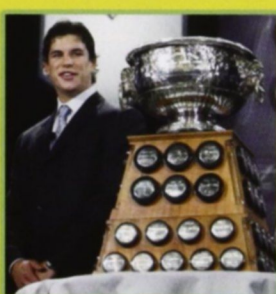

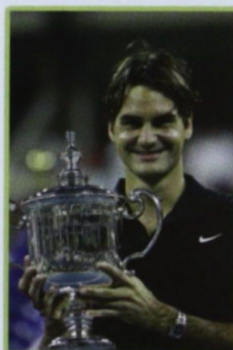

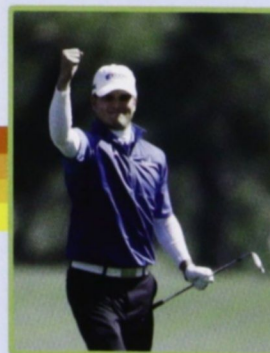

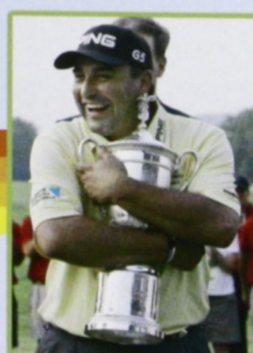

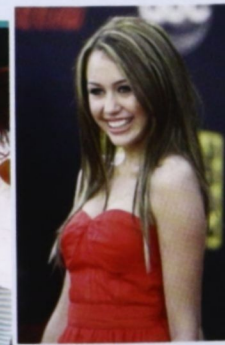

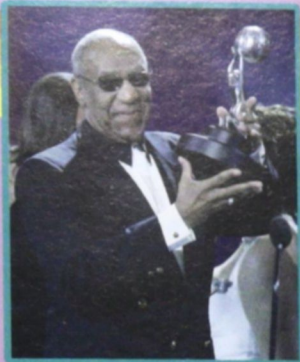

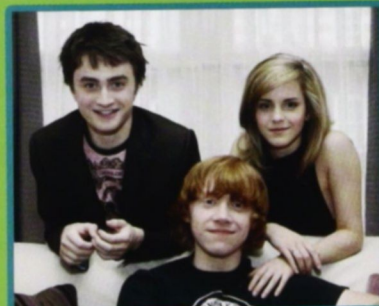
