



## WAR AGAINST TERRORISM



President Bush authorized the biggest change of the U.S. Government in fifty years. Over 100 agencies and 50,000 employees were merged into the DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY. Thomas Ridge of Pennsylvania was named the first Secretary of Homeland Defense. The department was given cabinet level status and becomes America's security watchdog.

## DISARMING IRAQ



Under Security Council Resolution 1441 the U.N. continued efforts to disarm Iraq. On December 7, Iraq furnished a 12,000 page declaration they claimed detailed their nuclear, chemical and biological activities. U.N. inspectors visited sites in Iraq in an attempt to determine compliance with the resolution. Debate continues on the authenticity of the reports and the truthfulness of Iraq's destruction of their weapons of mass destruction.





## WORLD SERIES WINNER





## SALT LAKE 2002




