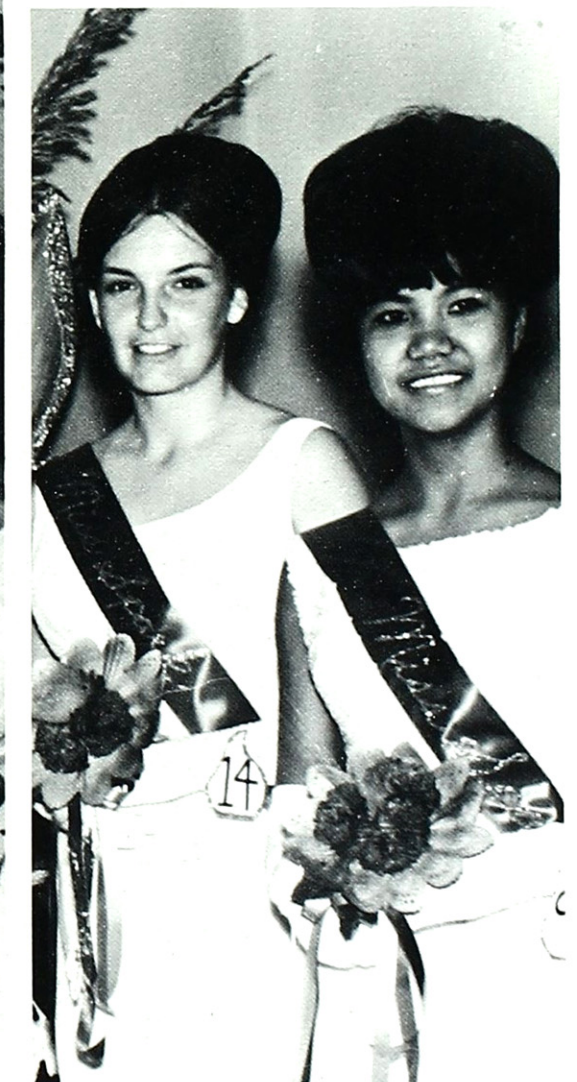

The Future Teachers of America at Fort Campbell High School was organized to better inform interested students in the field of teaching.

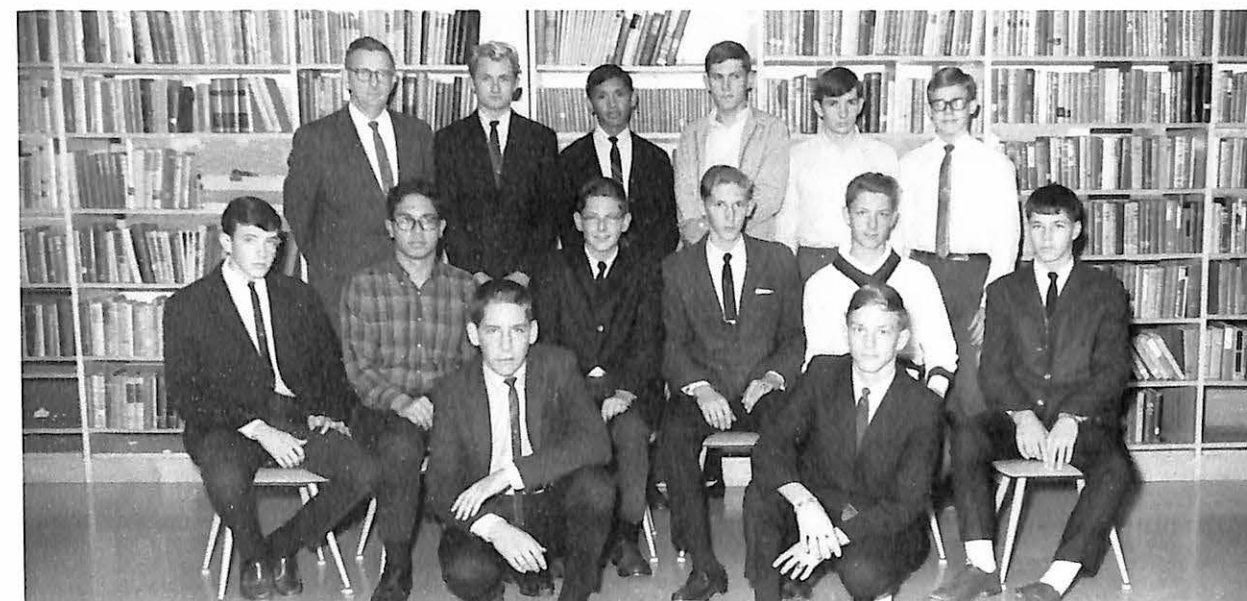

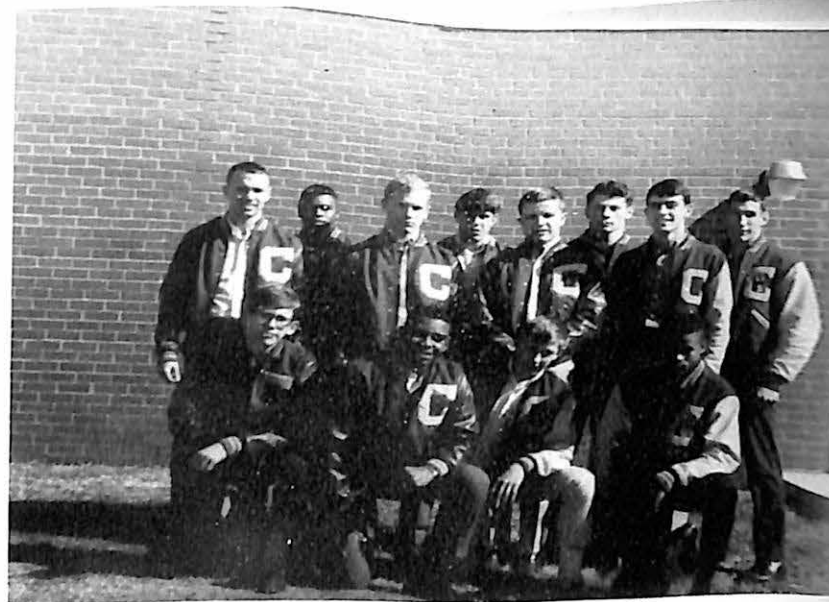
