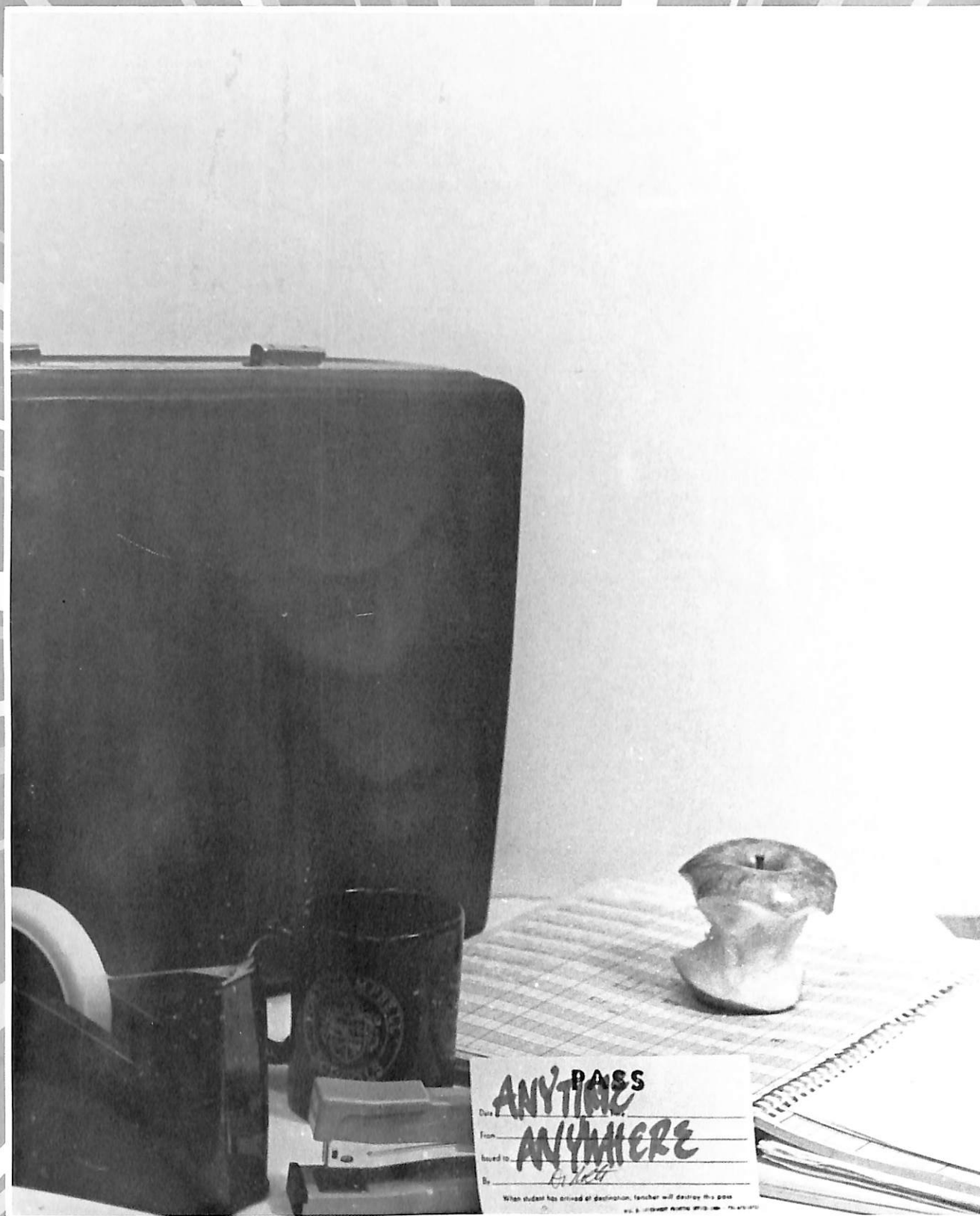
# One Last Look

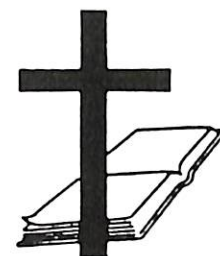

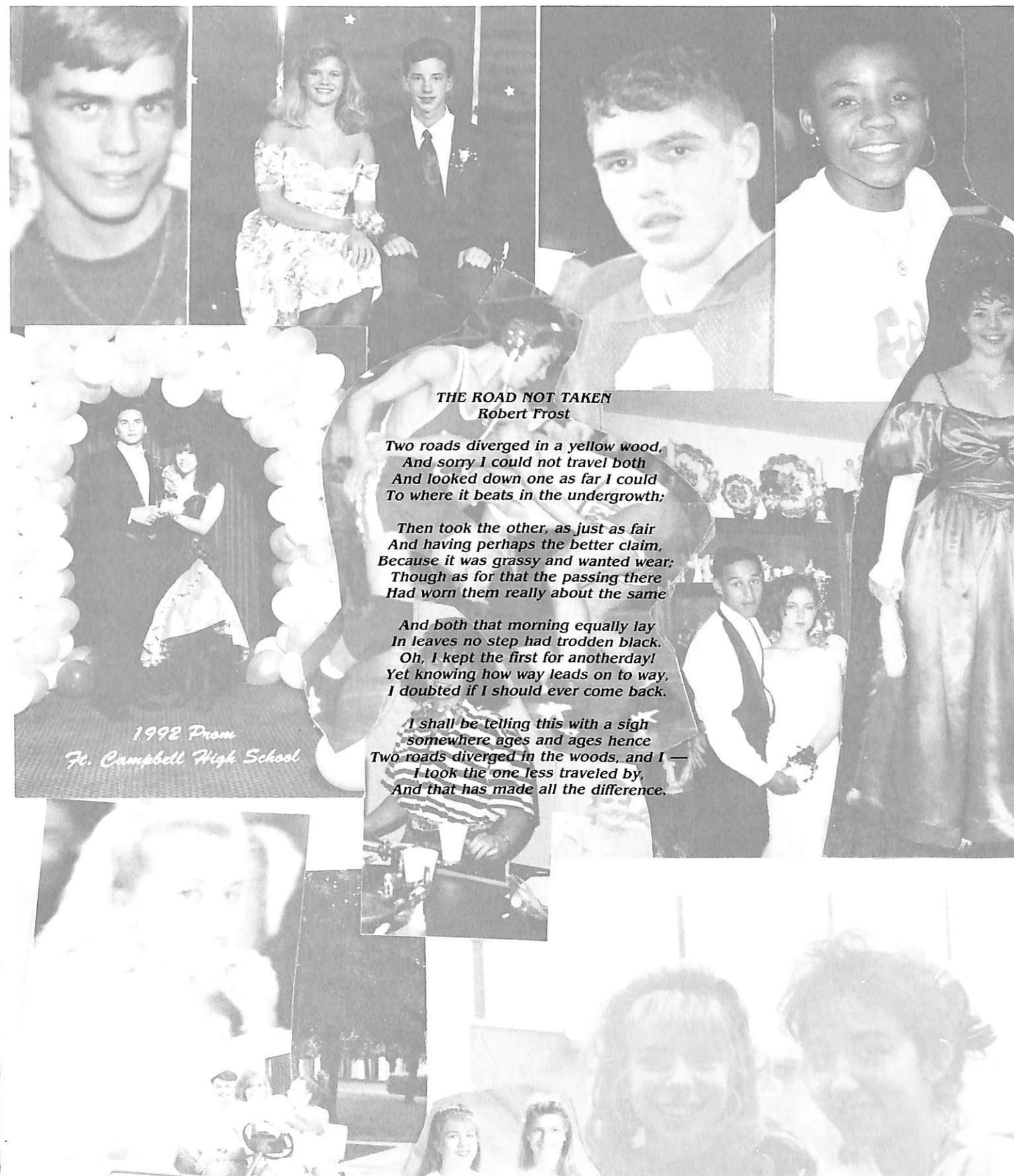

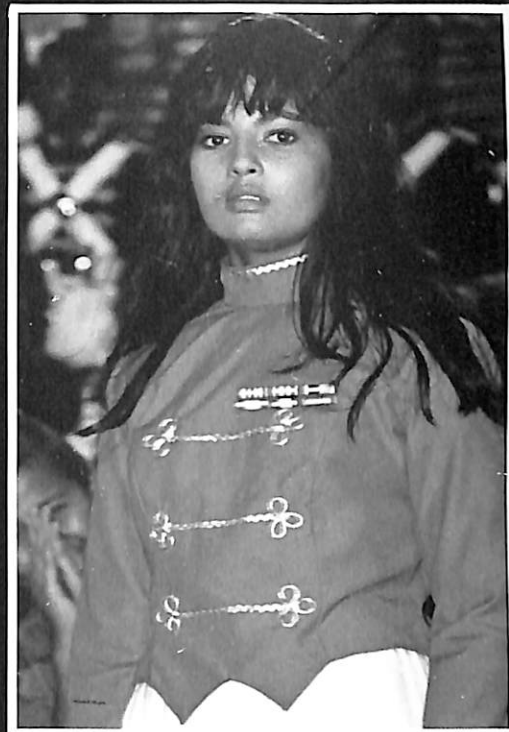
# 1992 MARCHING BAND

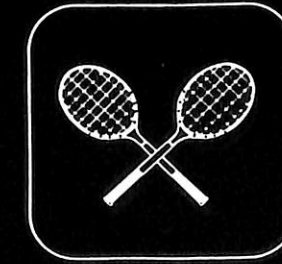

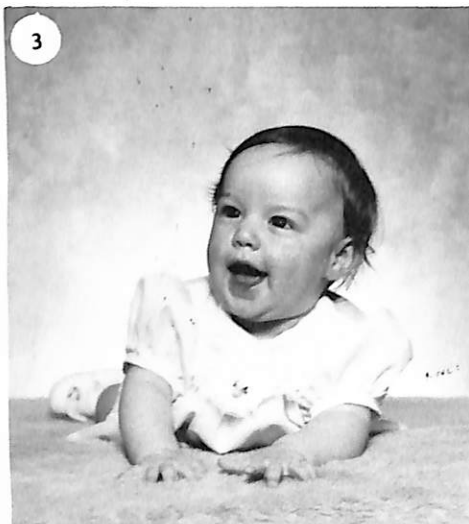

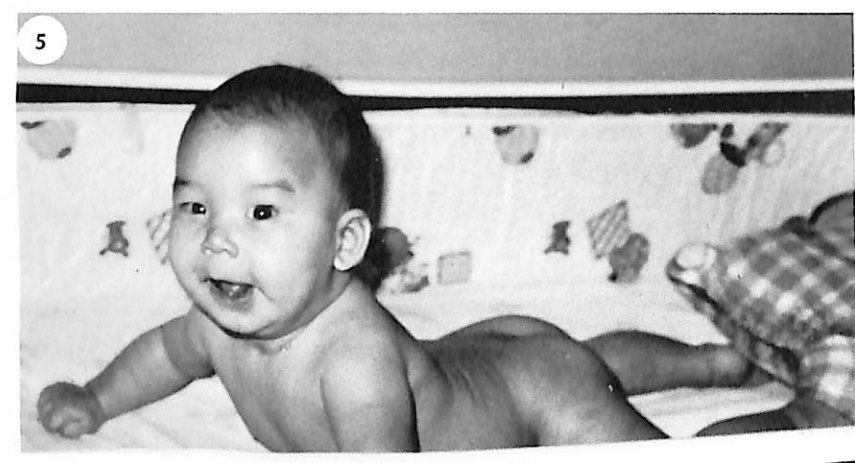

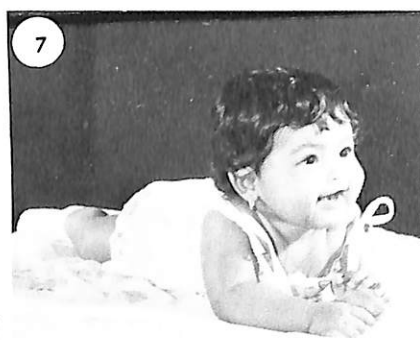


photo 7 This baby was the band director her junior and senior year. Who is she?

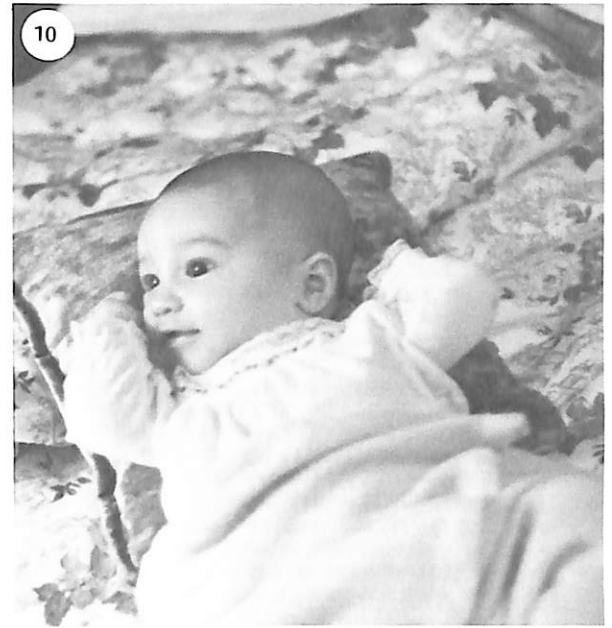
