















Mr. Clark Johns, Jr.









The 1993-94 yearbook is dedicated to the memory of Mr. Clark Johns, Jr. Mr. Johns passed away on February 20, 1994, after a hard-fought battle with pancreatic cancer.

Mr. Johns served in the Vietnam War before attending Austin Peay State University. After attaining his teaching degree, Mr. Johns became a substitute teacher at Northwest for about four months. Soon after this Mr. Johns began to work in the Fort Campbell School System, where he was a dedicated teacher for twenty-three years. "It was important to him that he was helping kids make futures for themselves," said teacher Greg Gillis. Mr. Johns believed it was important to keep "exercising the mind."

Mr. Johns has said that he wanted to grow up to be just like his dad. He was an advocate for the family. His wife, Judy, and their four children (April, Janna, CJ, and Sarah) were his pride and joy and always came first. He was an avid supporter of the church and referred to the people of his church as family.

In the words of those who knew Mr. Johns best ... "He was very genuine, there was nothing phony about him," said teacher Lee Lange. Teacher Pam Briggs said, "He was very quick-witted, humorous, humble, vivacious, and always a gentleman." "He knew the ways of the world and the ways of the heart. He understood the value of laughter and the power of faith. He cherished his God, his family, his home, his country, his jokes (good and bad), his students (good and bad), and his friends," said teacher Rose Garrett.

Mr. Johns was an excellent teacher, a good friend, and a loving father and husband. Those who knew him will always remember that, "It's a fine day to be in the Army, don't you know."
