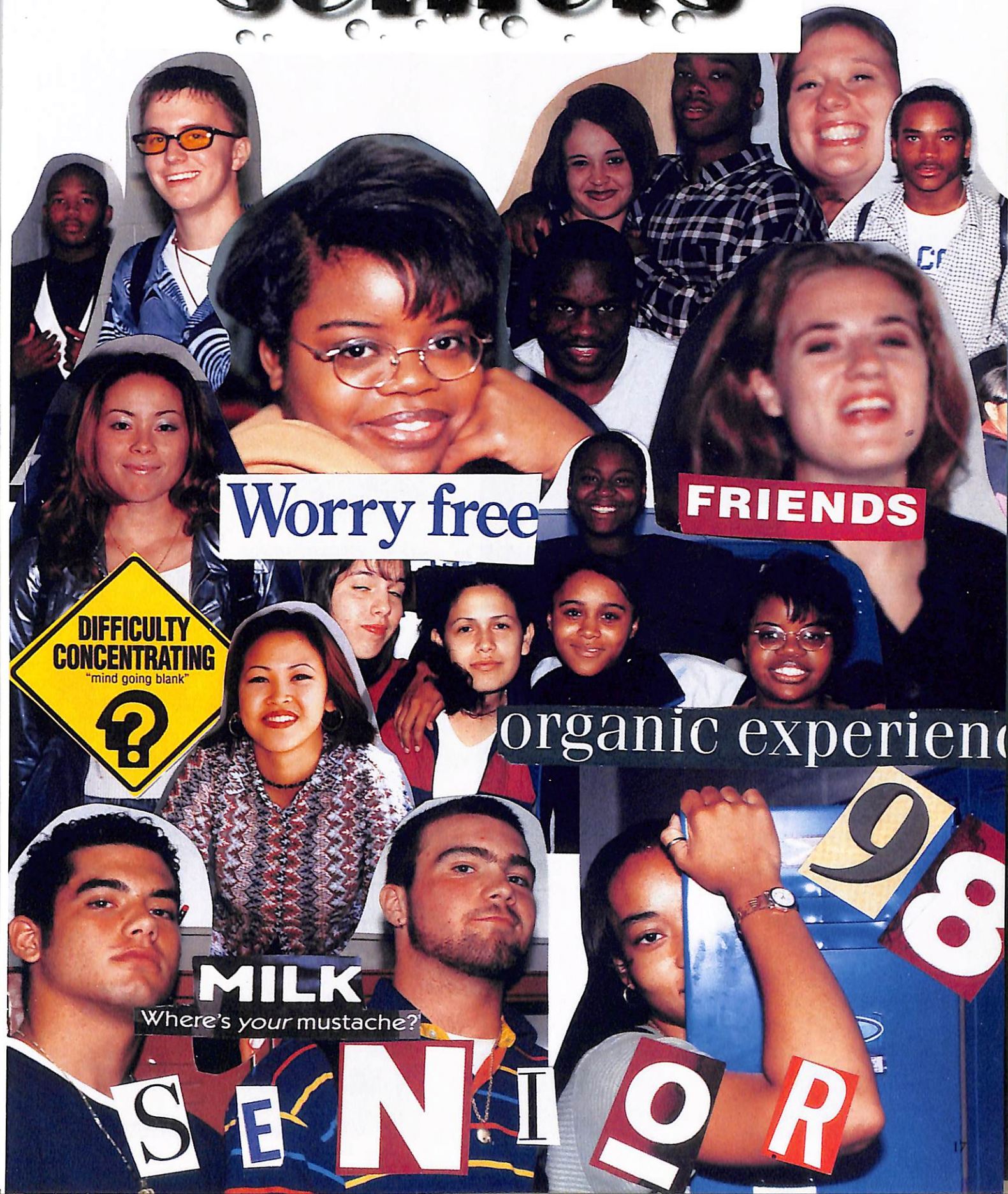
I continue to draw strength and faith from my horse, for each day is a blessing. Thank you to everyone that ever shared this with me. Cowgirls Rule!

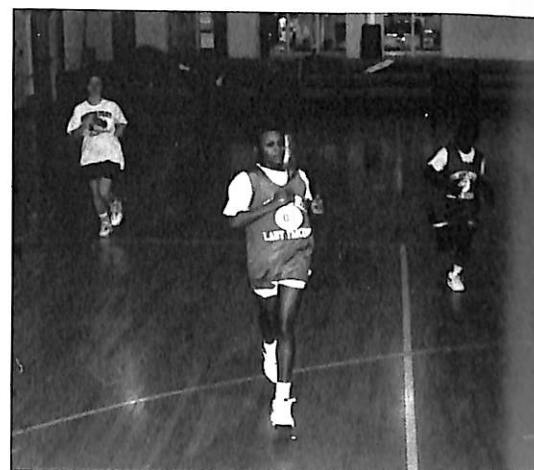

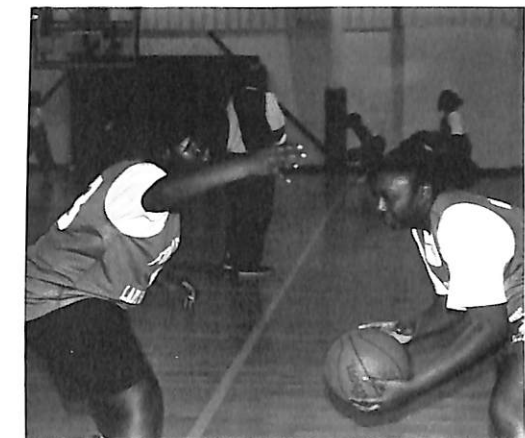
