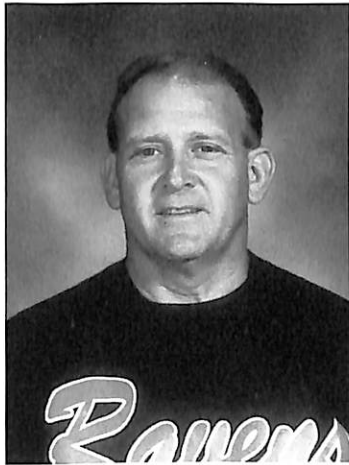

Coach Fisher and Coach Darke are the Drivers Ed teachers. Coach Fisher divides his teaching of wellness here and at the middle schools.

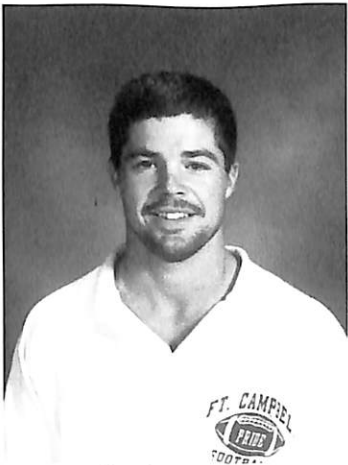

Next year, God willing, I will attend the US Air Force Academy and major in Space Operations.

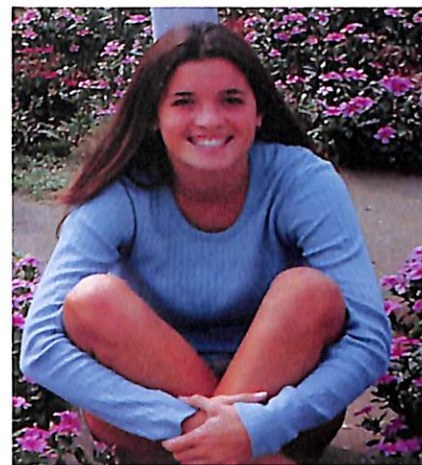
