
National German Honor Society is based upon both German and overall academic excellence. Members are inducted each spring.





Excel Recipients

The Clarksville-Montgomery County Chamber of Commerce initiated the Excelling in Education program in 1988. It is an ongoing cooperative effort of the Chamber and local businesses to honor area high school students who have achieved academic excellence or who have been models of exemplary citizens in the school setting. Three catagories of cards are awarded-gold, silver, and blue. The gold cards are given to students who have recieved all A's for the semester. Silver Cards are awarded who recieved any combination of A's and B's for the semester. Several stipulations apply to Blue card recipients. Possible candidates are nominated by a faculty member; these candidates must have no semester grade lower than a C, a clean disciplinary record, and an outstanding attendance record. The number of blue cards is limited to 25% of the total Gold and Silver cards awarded. Students recieve discounts from participating area merchants. In addition, several school-based incentives are given to the honorees. These awards include an off-campus lunch on the assembly date and various coupons for free products.
