My advice to those who still look forward to graduation-- remember to say thank you for the gifts you have been given: opportunity and knowl-





honors night, our students are recognized for their many achievements. Also our graduates are well represented at the most selective colleges and universities.


Our mission and beliefs drive all educational decisions at FCHS, but our vision is much greater than the sum of these statements. We

Don't be reckless with other people's hearts. Don't put up with people who are reckless with yours.


Don't waste your time on jealousy. Sometimes you're ahead, sometimes you're behind. The race is long and, in the end, it's only with yourself.
