Thanks to both Ken and Joel, our "Dynamic Duo" for making a difference in the lives in our Fort Campbell Community.

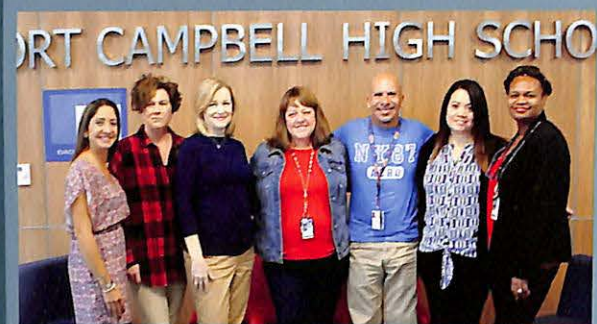
