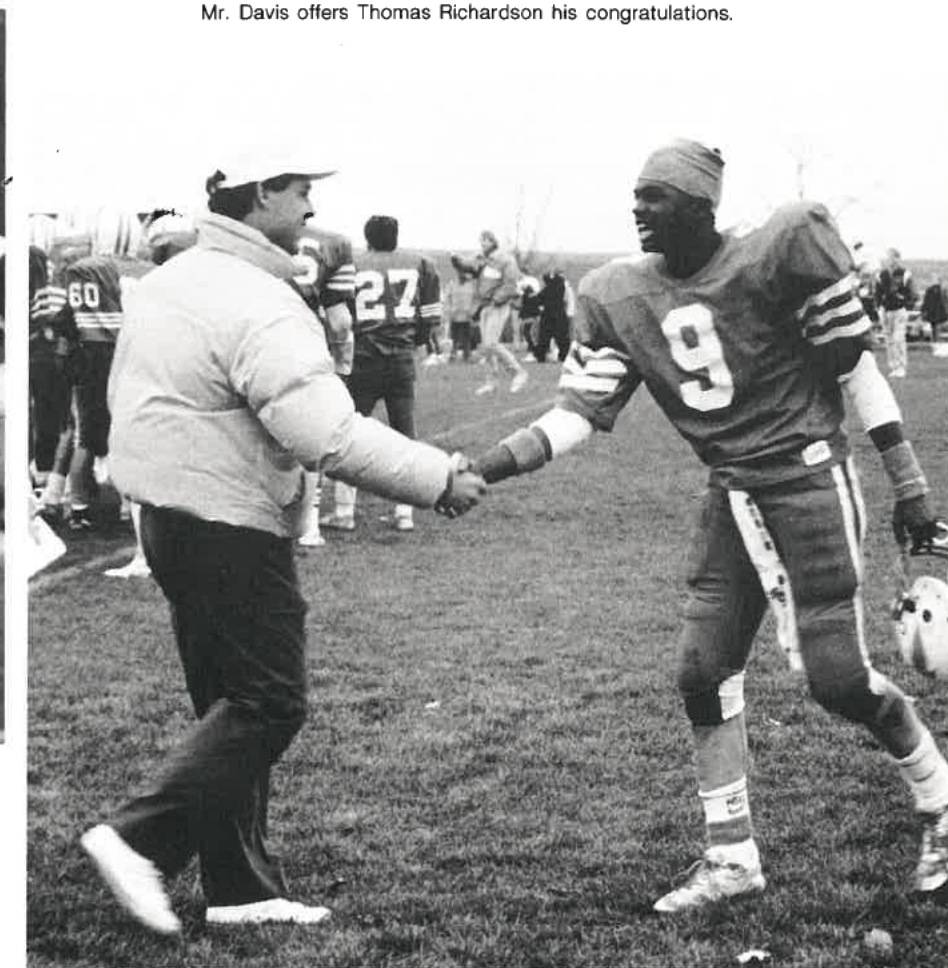
Fulda Repeats, Repeats, Repeats!
