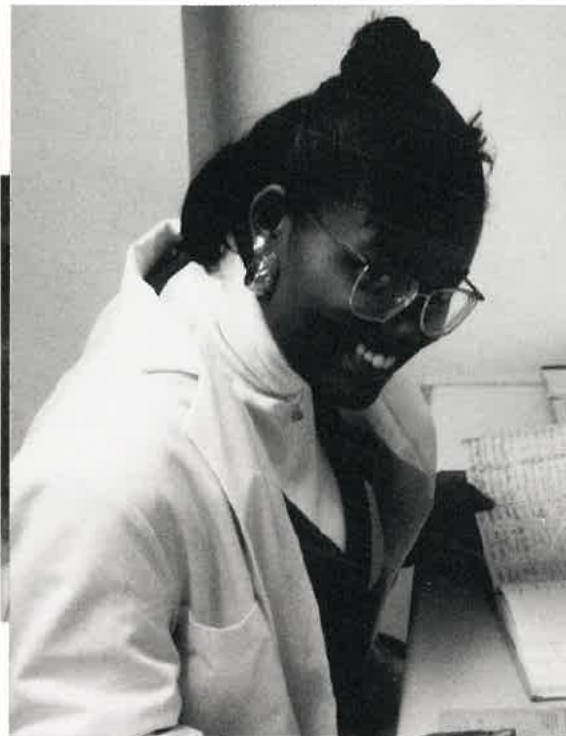

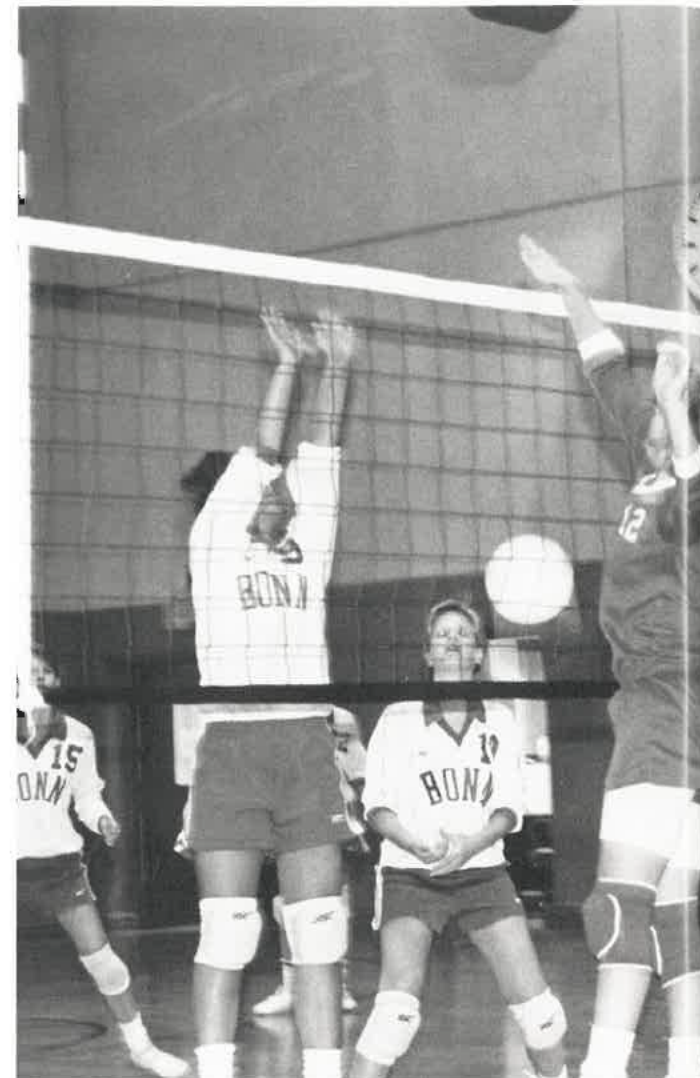
Run, Spike, Win! Cross Country & Volleyball Teams Travel Together

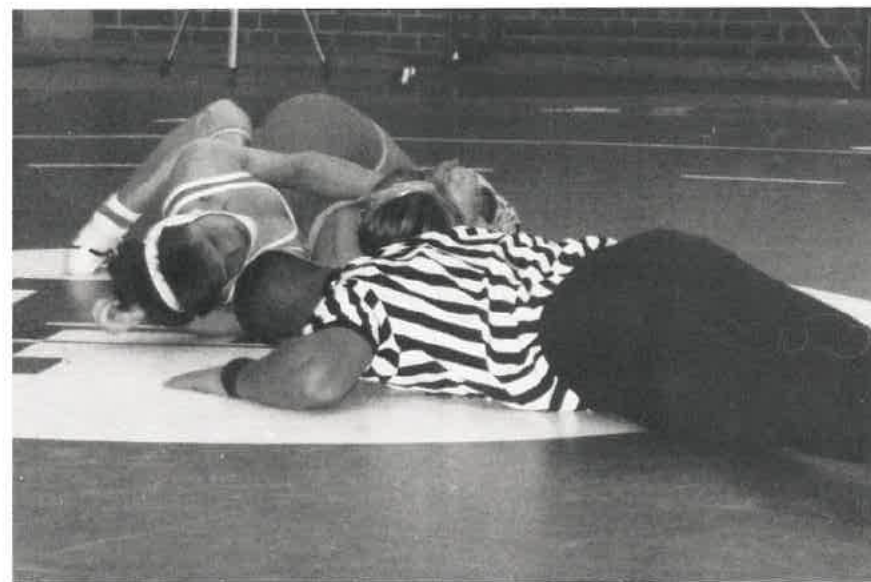

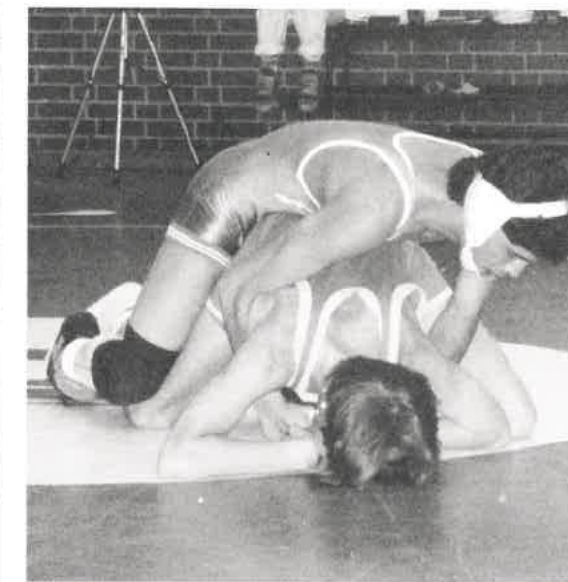
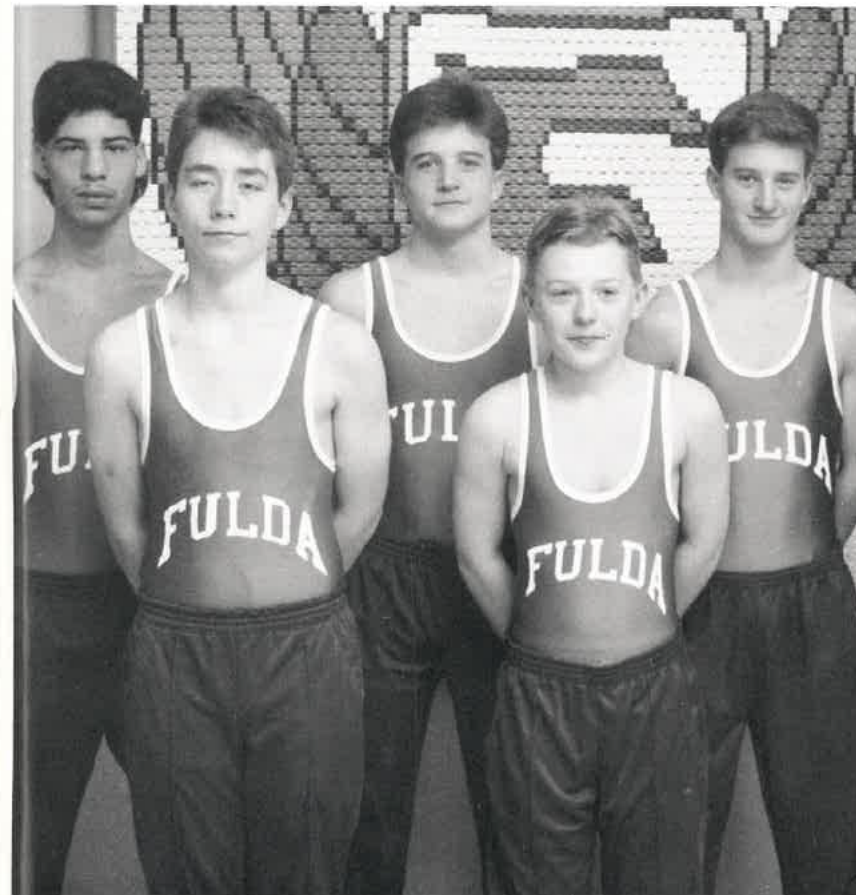

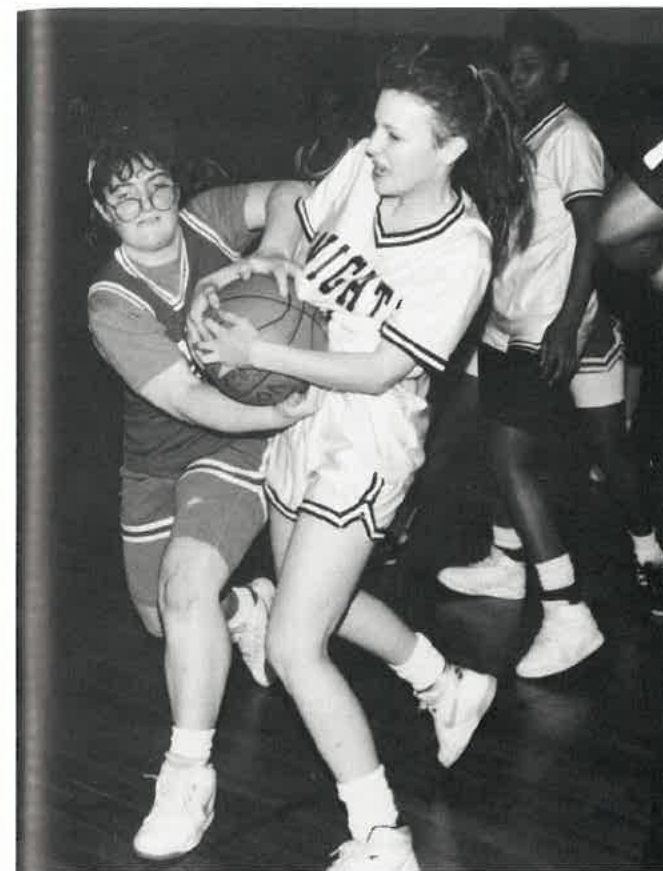

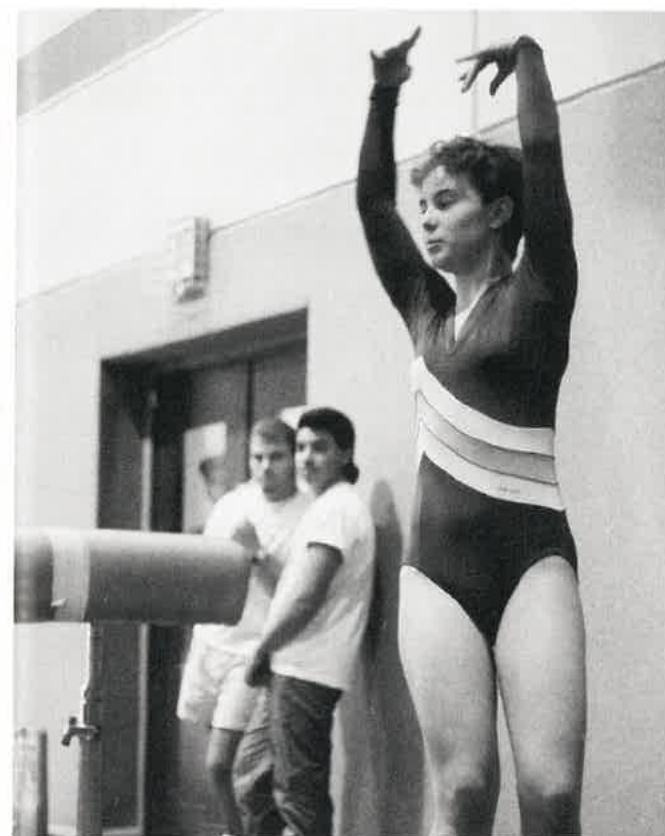
