Whether your flights are long or short may they be rewarding and successful to you.

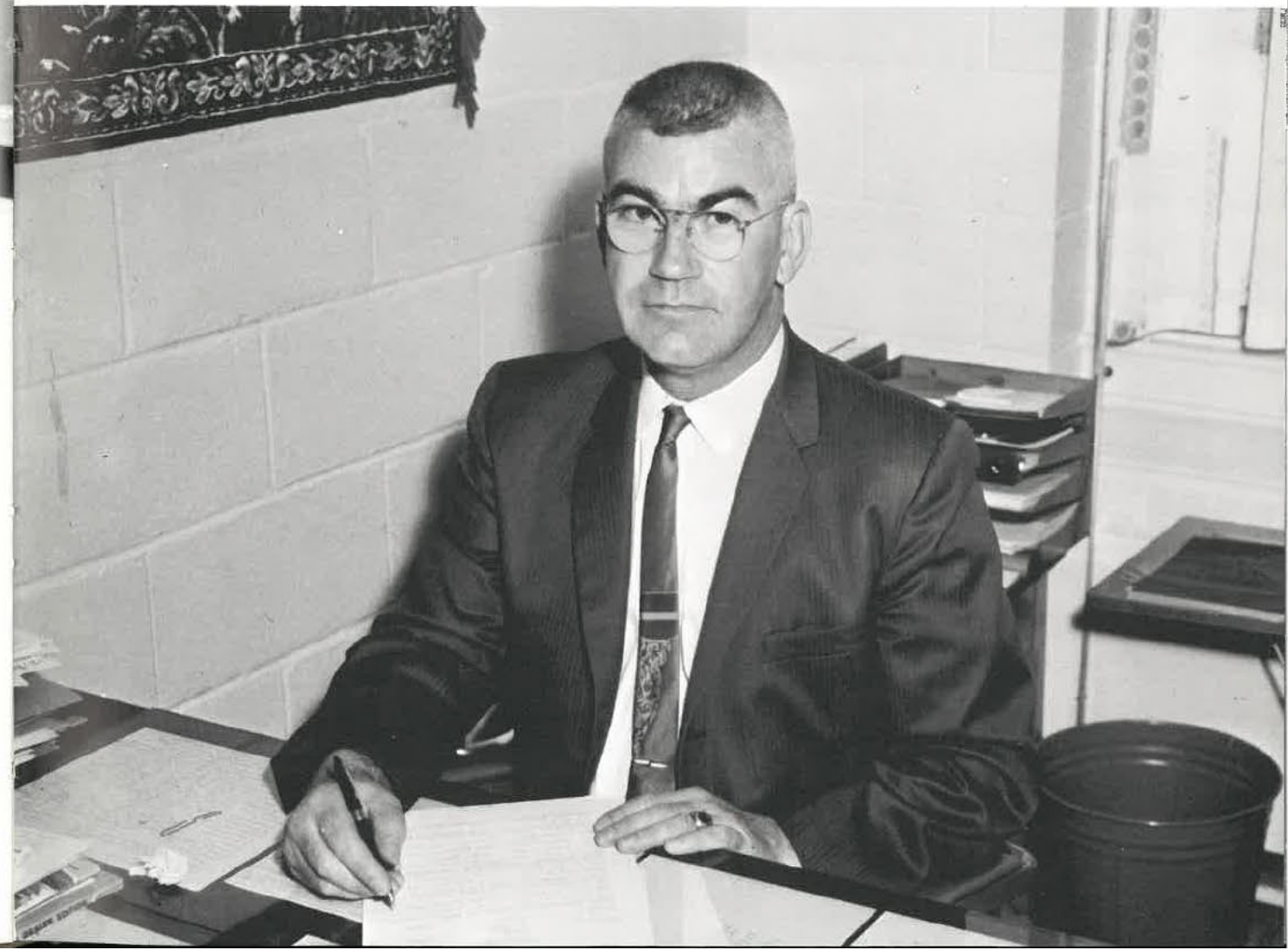

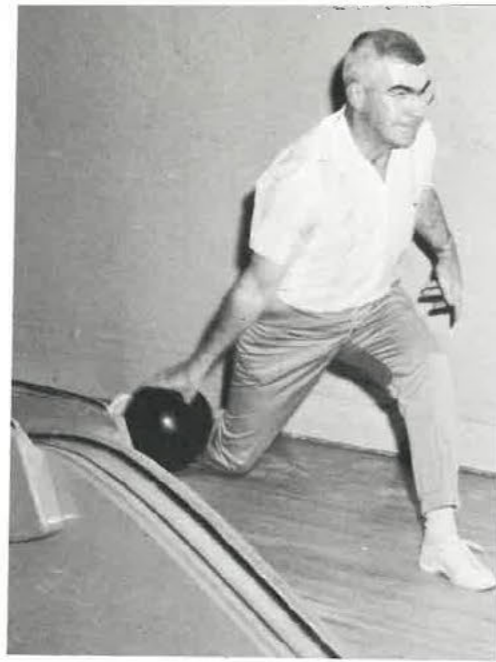
FRESHMAN SLAVE SALE
