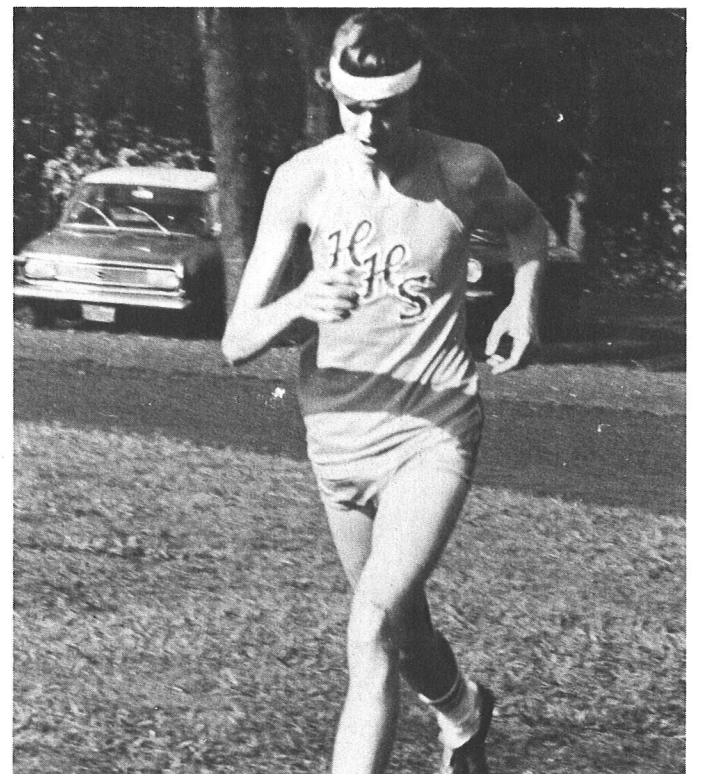


Ellen Strecker Most Valuable Varsity

The Girls Gymnastics Team had an undefeated season competing against a total of 10 USDESEA Schools.

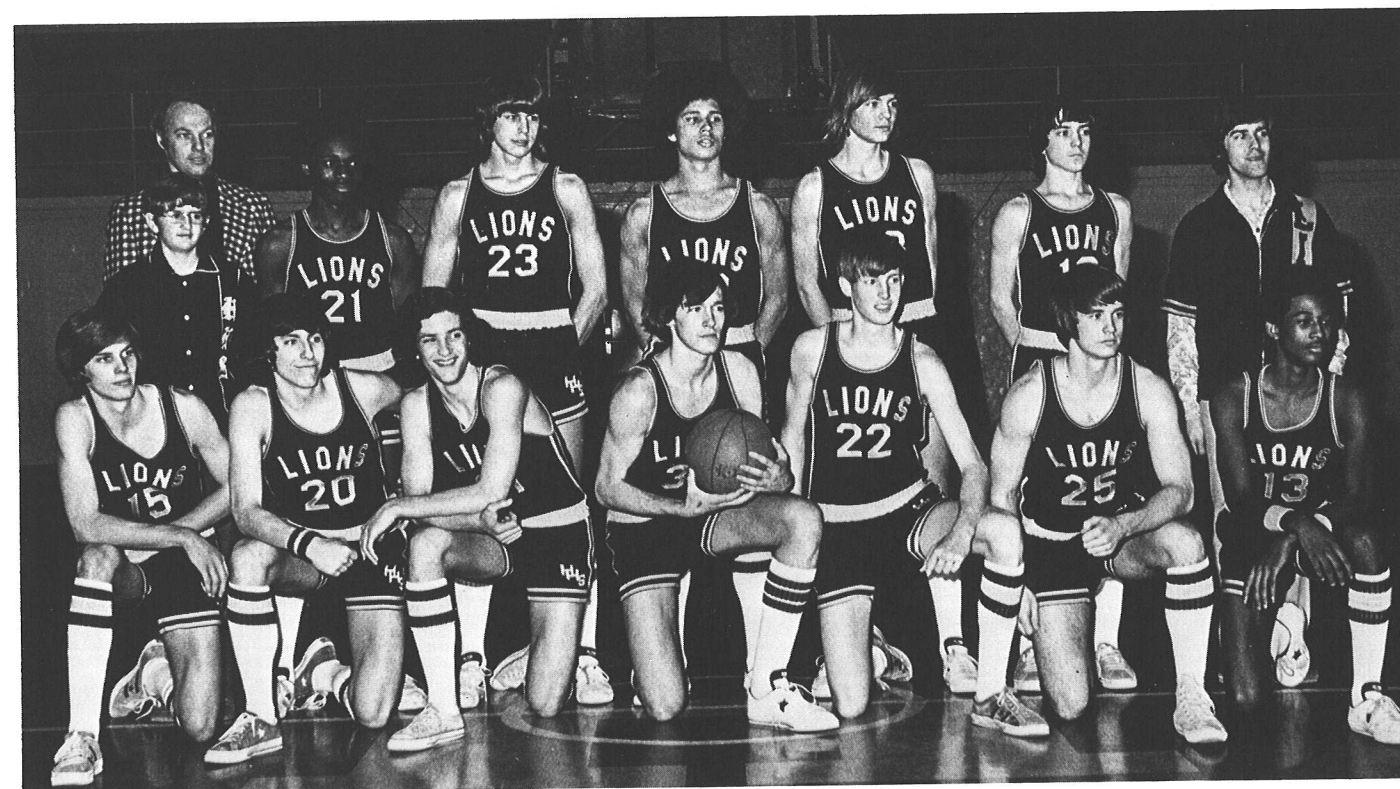
