The English program is broken down into 6 basic groups, Drama, Speech, Journalism, Cinema, Literature, and basic grammar.



Drama is a study of play production; performing arts skills including stage craft, lighting, and makeup, leading to production of one act plays.


Journalism is practical experience in reporting, editing, and advertising. The main focus of the course is the publication of the school newspaper.




