The Hohenfels FEA group was much larger this year than last years! It was a great thing, and like the year before they had a blast at the conference in Edelweiss. They even went ice skating!



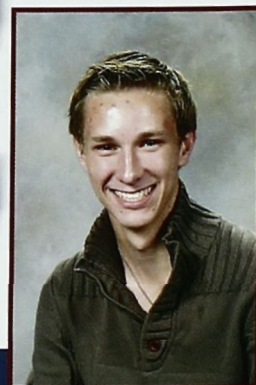
Academic Bowl!
