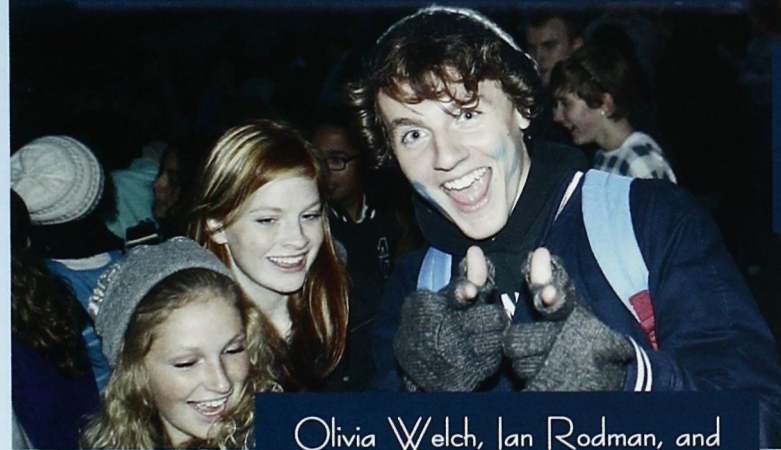

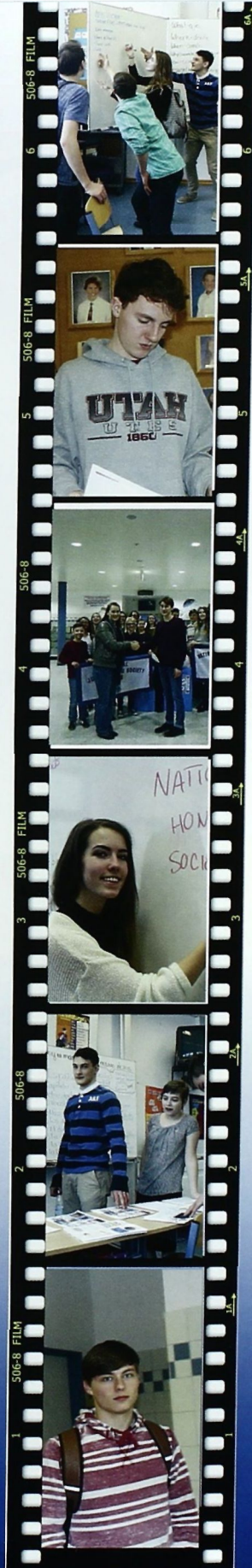
NHS & NJHS

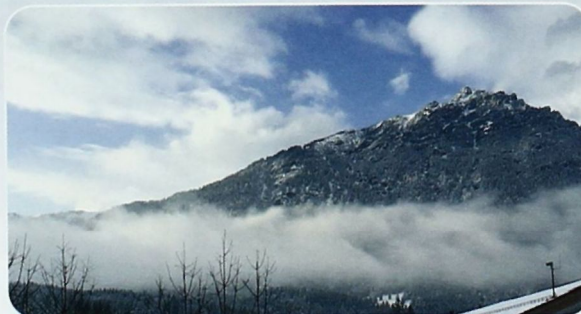

The German department in Hohenfels Middle/High School is a place to learn about the diverse culture we are immersed in by living here.

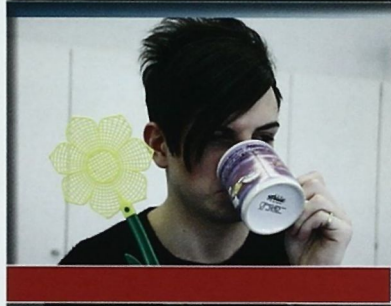


Chris Lucios (12 Grade)

Was ist deine Lieblingsstadt, die wir auf einen Schulausflug besucht haben?

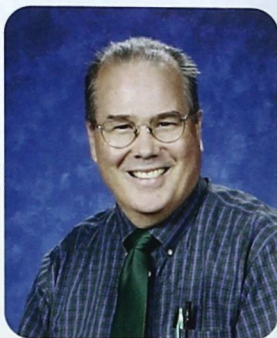

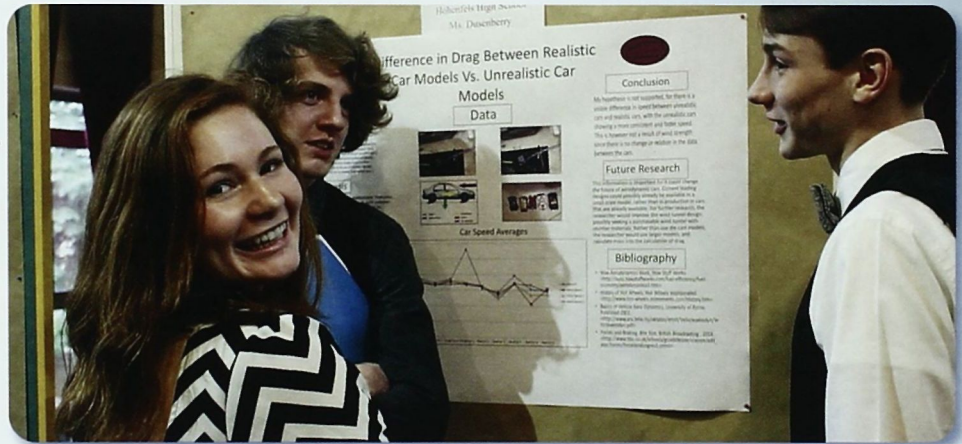


JSHS SYMPOSIUM

Outdoor Education is run by the Hohenfels JROTC program with help from the local Outdoor Recreation and is open to all HMHS high schoolers.



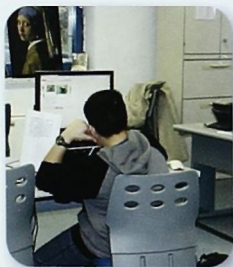
