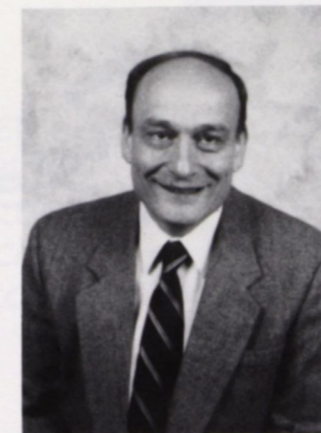
## **A FEW LINES FROM THE PRINCIPAL**

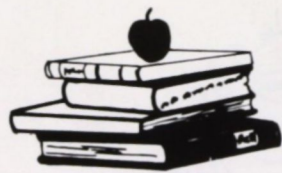


# A FEW LINES FROM THE ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL
