Principal's Message

FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK:

1962-63 has seen many historical developments. Not least among these was the Kennedy-Khrushchev dispute over Cuba.

The world lost such great figures as Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt and Robert Frost. In our school, developments were less momentous. To us, however, they were just as important. We have had the largest enrollment in the history of the Izmir complex of schools; soccer was offered to our boys--while they lost most of their games to the Turkish players--the good will that was developed will live after the defeats on the field. The Governor of Izmir and the Minister of Education paid us a visit, the first such visit by leading Turkish officials to the American school. Turkish was offered as a third language to many of our students. The Twist seemed to be still the most popular dance. Dramatics, the Junior Classical League, athletics, journalism, and Junior Red Cross were a few of the extra-curricular activities that complemented our academic work.

But most of all, we have had a good faculty and a good student body who will go into a world that needs new leaders. In this world each one will play an important part.

It is good that we have been in Turkey together.
I will add only one small bit of advice--live humbly with
God while walking among human giants.

Mustafa Kemal Ataturk was a "Prophet of Turkey." Born in 1881, he was named Mustafa-as common a name in the Near East as John is in the West. At the Military School of Salonika, his teacher of mathematics, a Captain Mustafa, dubbed him "Kemal," the Arabic word meaning "Perfection." When he ordered all Turks to adopt family

names, the Grand National

Assembly requested him to assume the name of "Ataturk" - first and foremost of his country.

raise from the ashes. He did not found a world-wide religion, as Mohammed did, but he introduced the creed of the Westinto Turkey. It was the creed of progress, the creed of future. He did not erect shrines in honor of the invisible ruler of the universe. His god was the Nation. He gave the life an entirely new set of values, new objects of adoration.
