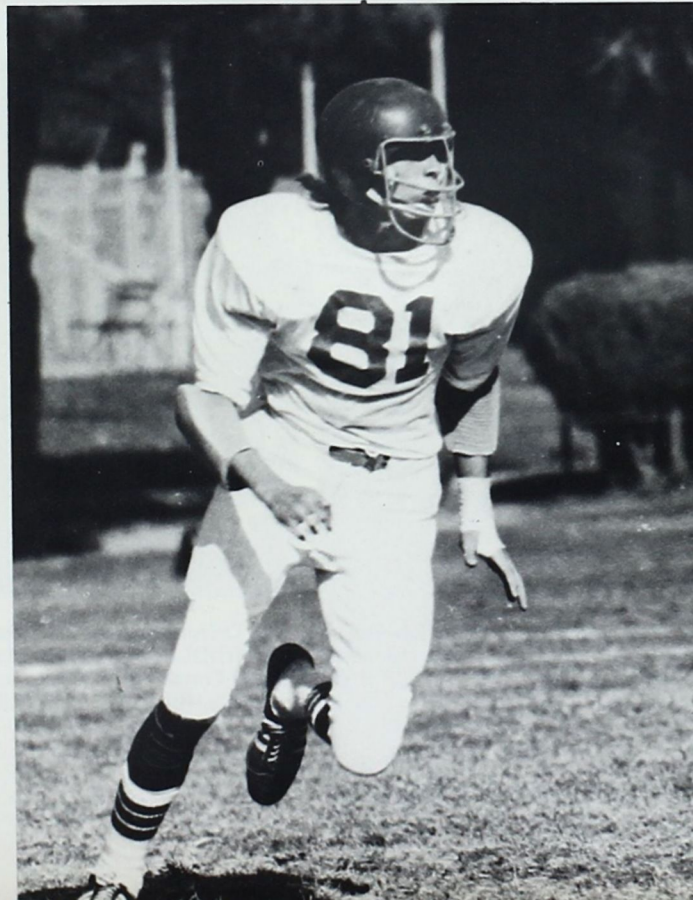

The name of the organization shall be the Student Council Association of the American Dependent High School in Izmir, Turkey.

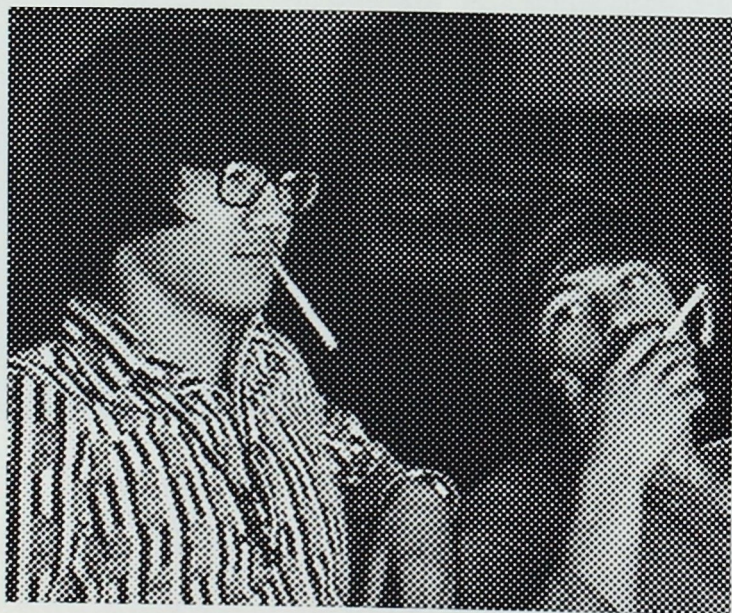
ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

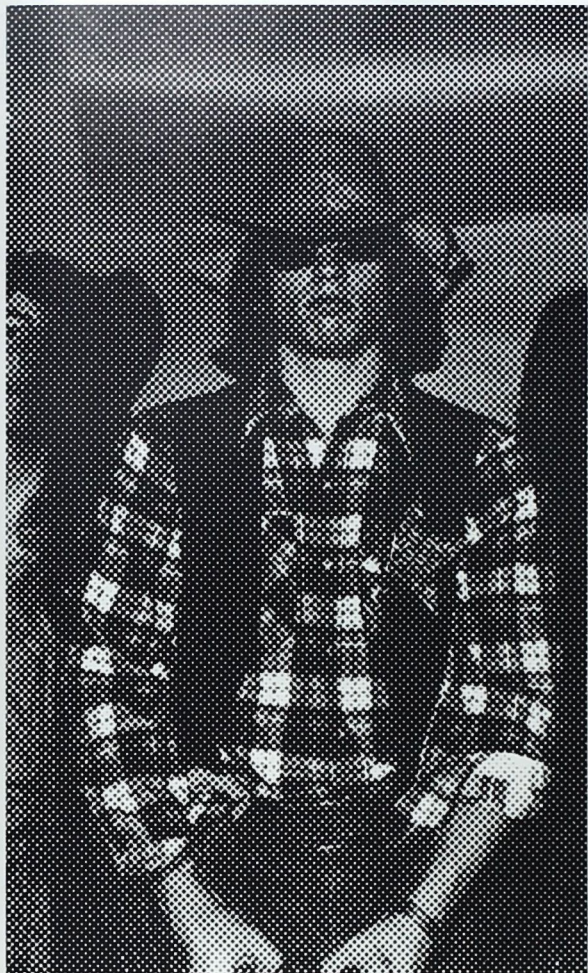
