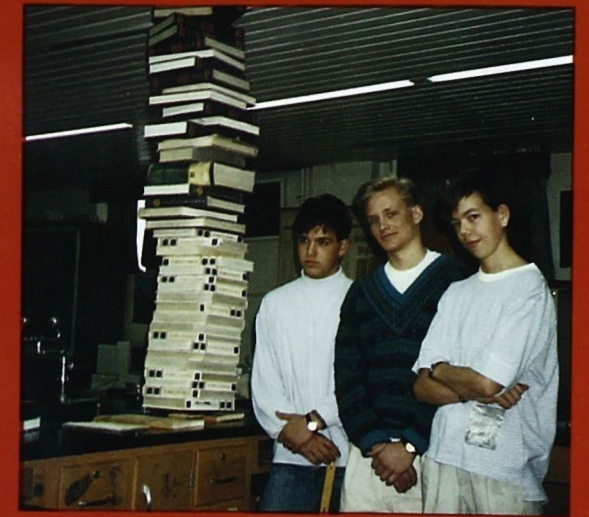




PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

All in all, it's been a year that will be remembered (like it or not) by anyone who went to IHS this year.

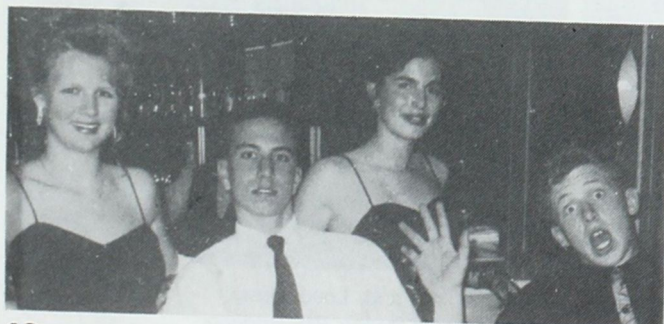
