RICHARD "CARSON" SEELEY BELOVED MATH TEACHER

RICHARD "CARSON" SEELEY WAS MATH A TEACHER AT KAISER-SLAUTERN MIDDLE SCHOOL. HE WAS A GREAT TEACHER, FRIEND TO MANY, AND DEARLY MISSED BY ALL WHO KNEW HIM. HE WAS BORN IN NEW JERSEY IN 1930, AND WAS A VERY ADVENTUROUS MAN WITH A GREAT ZEST FOR LIFE.

HE SERVED A TOUR WITH THE U.S. ARMY INTELLIGENCE IN BERLIN, GERMANY IN 1955. WHEN HE CAME BACK, SOMETHING INDESCRIBABLE HAPPENED TO HIM THAT HE COULD NEVER TALK ABOUT. CARSON WAS STRONG, BUT STILL, HE WAS FILLED WITH PAIN. AFTER THAT, HE WAS NEVER THE SAME; HE WAS A DIFFERENT MAN ALTOGETHER.

HIS INTEREST IN PHOTOGRAPHY AND MILITARY HISTORY EARNED HIM A CUM LAUDE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE FROM MARYVILLE COLLEGE IN MARYVILLE, TENNESSEE, IN 1952 AND A MASTERS OF ARTS DEGREE FROM BASIL STATE UNIVERSITY IN 1972.

CARSON BEGAN TEACHING MATH AT DODDS IN AUGUST 1964, AND TAUGHT FOR ALMOST 30 YEARS. HE LOVED TEACHING AND CALLED HIS STUDENTS THE CHILDREN HE NEVER HAD, ENJOYED BEING "MEAN" BY ASSIGNING HOMEWORK TO HIS STUDENTS. HE JOKED ABOUT HIMSELF OFTEN AND CALLED HIMSELF "THE DINOSAUR" BECAUSE OF HIS AGE. EVERY DAY AFTER SCHOOL, HE WOULD GRADE PAPERS, THEN HEAD OUT TO THE ROD AND GUN CLUB TO WITH HIS FRIENDS. CARSON CALLED IT HIS SECOND HOME. "HE WOULD COME IN EVERY CHANCE HE GOT", RECALLED SOME OF HIS FRIENDS.

ON AUGUST 2, 1994, CARSON WENT TO THE ROD AND GUN CLUB SAYING HE HAD PAINS IN HIS CHEST AND ARMS. THESE ARE TWO SYMPTOMS OF A HEART ATTACK, THE ATTACK THAT WOULD LATER IN THE DAY CLAIM HIS LIFE.

THREE DAYS LATER IN THE ROD AND GUN CLUB, AN AQAINTANCE OF CARSON'S BEGAN TO WORRY ABOUT HIM BECAUSE HE HADN'T BEEN AT THE CLUB. A MAN AT THE CLUB TOLD HIM THAT CARSON WAS PROBABLY IN LONDON AS CARSON HAD MENTIONED HE WANTED TO GO THERE BEFORE THE END OF THE SUMMER. BUT, THE MAN WOULD NOT ACCEPT THAT FOR AN ANSWER, HE DROVE TO CARSON'S HOME IN EINSIEDLERHOF AND KNOCKED ON THE DOOR. HE KNOCKED AT LEAST THREE TIMES BEFORE HE OPENED THE UNLOCKED DOOR. HE FOUND HIS FRIEND ON THE COUCH WATCHING A WORLD WAR II MOVIE ON INSTANT REPLAY. FROM THE BODY POSITION, HE COULD TELL CARSON HAD PASSED AWAY.

CARSON WAS A FAMILY FRIEND OF OURS. THOUGH HE HAD ONLY SPENT ONE CHRISTMAS DINNER AT OUR HOME, HE WAS ALWAYS WELCOME. I WILL ALWAYS REMEMBER THE LAST TIME I SAW HIM, I WAS ON MY WAY TO LONDON FOR VACATION. MY MOTHER AND I WERE AT KAPAUN SHOPPETTE AND WE RAN INTO CARSON. HE GAVE ME A HUG, AND WISHED ME WELL ON MY JOURNEY AND ASKED ME TO GIVE HIM ALL THE DETAILS WHEN I GOT BACK.

I NEVER DID SEE HIM
AGAIN. THE DAY I WAS
TOLD OF HIS DEATH, A
PART OF ME DIED WITH
HIM. HIS DEATH SADENED NOT ONLY MY
FAMILY, BUT MANY OF HIS
COLLEAGUES, FRIENDS,
AND FORMER STUDENTS
AS WELL. THUS PARTED
RICHARD "CARSON" SEELEY, DEAD AT AGE 64, IN
AUGUST 1994.
